

## OCTOBER 30, 2016 BULLETIN RAY'S REMARKS:

THE K.E. FAMILY LIFELINE

I hope everyone is having a great week so far. Although fall is here, it has seemed a little more like summer the last few days. Well, I'm sure if we wait a few days things will change again. This is no doubt one of the realities of living in the Ozarks.

Let me take a moment and remind you all that this coming Sunday is a 5<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY. As you already know, we are going to have a special push this Sunday for a mission contribution for the preachers' training school in Ghana. Everything above our regular budget will go toward the Ghana Institute of Christian Studies. As I reported a few months ago, we are trying to raise the money necessary to get the Ghana Institute of Christian Studies off the ground. Our plan is to begin in January of 2017. So far we have commitments of around a 1/3 of the needed one time monies (\$10,000 of \$30,000 needed). We have also secured \$500 a month of the total monthly support needed, which is \$3000 (only \$2500 left to go). However, I remind you that within the one-time needs above is a six month buffer to sustain the school while other moneys are raised. So I encourage us all to dig a little deeper and give extra this 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday so that we can get this new full time work off the ground. How wonderful it will be to train preachers full time in West Africa, just as we are in East Africa and Southern Africa. God is good and continues to bless all of our efforts together for Him. Praise be to God.

With this in mind, I will have the privilege of visiting with a few congregations before the end of the year to present this good work. Over the next few months, if I happen to be gone on a Wednesday night, or during a service, that's where I will be. Please remember this good work and the preparations being made in your prayers. With determination, focus and work on our part and with God on our side, all things truly are possible.

Well, remember that tonight we again have the opportunity to come together and study God's Word, as well as to worship together. I hope we will all be present and ready to give God our best. Certainly, it is always a blessing when we are able to approach the throne of our God and Praise Him. Also remember the importance of the Lord's day this coming weekend. How wonderful it will be to give the Lord our time on His Day! God bless!
