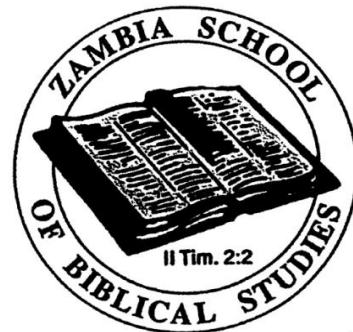

Please continue to pray for this good work, as we raise funds and as the preparations are being made for the school. With God's continued help and blessings we are going to meet and exceed this needed goal.

I wanted to take a moment and thank all of you who came on Friday night to honor Trey and Ruth. I know we are all going to miss seeing them around on a regular basis, but they are doing a good work in Omaha and I know the Lord will continue to bless them. Thank you all for showing them such love and kindness!

I hope you all have a great week and keep in mind that we will have several opportunities to gather and worship God. I know you will be present to take advantage of the privilege to come before God's Throne. So, I'll see you Wednesday night and Sunday morning. God bless!
