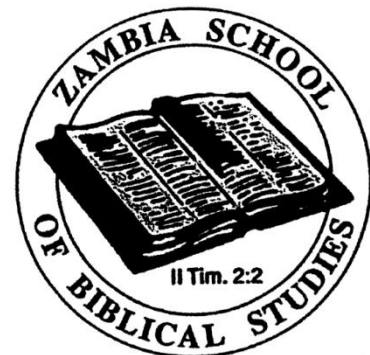

Time is flying by and soon we will be making the long journey home. It passes by so quickly. Edith and I are both doing fine. We are able to do the work we always do when we come here and even more. The school is doing well. I am very happy with the progress of the students in their knowledge and understanding of the Word of God and their ability to preach. You would be proud of them. This is a young class, but it will be one of the best.

I had an opportunity to go to a congregation where one of our graduates preaches which is only a little over 50 miles from the school. It took us 3 and 1/2 hours to get there due to the condition and what some people might call a road. Anyway, it was way back in the bush but when we arrived the brethren were there ready to worship God. There were over 50 present in a building that was built by them and a nice one at that. One sister responded for prayer for her sins. She spoke of the many temptations she has had to face. This same preacher, one of the graduates started a school several years ago and at this time has 6 men training to be gospel preachers in a two-year program. Two other brothers, our graduates, who leave a long way away, travel once a week to teach at this school which teaches in the Tonga language. What a joy to be with them! They said they never thought we would visit with them and I'm glad we did. So many are being taught by those we train as well as other faithful schools throughout Africa. Thank you all for your support and faithfulness to the work.

I will close for now. We will be back on the 24<sup>th</sup> of August. Our love to you all. Keep us in your prayers. You are in our daily prayers. See you soon, the Lord willing.
