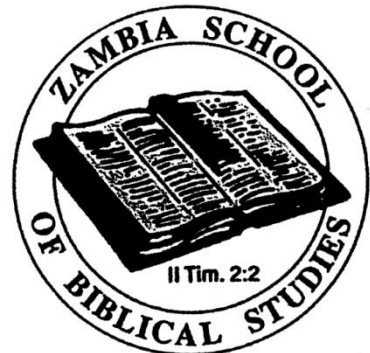

Hello brethren! I hope you are enjoying the rain. It is nice to finally have some moisture after it has been dry for so long. It has certainly cooled things off a little as well. Anyway, I'm sure the heat will be back before we know it, so we better enjoy this short break while we can.

Well, as most of you know by now we were able to purchase a new shuttle bus for the work of the church. Also, I was able to sell our old bus last Saturday for \$3200. After a purchase price of \$12000, for the new bus we were able to put the \$3200 from the sale of the old bus directly toward our new purchase. We also had \$500 which had been donated in the past toward the purchase of a new bus. That means we are down to owing only \$8350 for the new bus. Lord willing, we will challenge the congregation on our next 5th Sunday in September to try and come up with another chunk of the remaining money owed. Also, in the recent past, some of you have shown some interest and willingness toward helping get a new bus, so if anyone is able and willing to help us knock out some more of this cost, that would be great. However, please don't take away from your regular offering to God as it goes to meet our weekly budgeted needs. Thank you all for you continue help with such needs as we continue to do the work of the Lord and as we strive to spread the gospel to a world that needs it!

I talked with Dad today and they are only a week away from actually leaving Zambia, next Tuesday. They will arrive back here in the U.S. on Thursday morning. Please keep them in your prayers that they will finish out their work in Zambia well and that they will have a safe journey home.

I look forward to our gathering tonight to study God's Word and to worship together! I know you will all want to be present. Let me encourage us all to be ready for the Lord's Day, which will be here before we know it. Until then, may we all put God first in everything, knowing that He always blesses the faithful.
