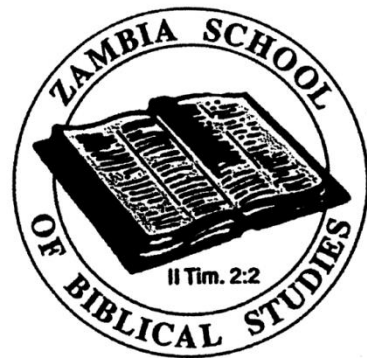

K.E. FAMILY LIFELINE

What's in a Name?

In the Bible, we find several names which are used to refer to an assembly of Christians or a specific congregation. Here are some examples:

Matthew 16:18	My church.	This shows it is Christ's church.
Acts 8:1	The church.	This shows it is the called out (ἐκκλησία).
1 Corinthians 1:2	The church of God.	This shows it belongs to God.
Romans 16:16	The churches of Christ.	This shows it belongs to Christ.
Ephesians 4:12	The body of Christ.	This shows it belongs to Christ.
1 Timothy 3:15	The church of the living God.	This shows ownership.
Hebrews 12:23	church of the firstborn.	This refers to first fruits or firstborn Christians.

Notice that all of these titles give the praise and devotion to Christ! It is Christ's church, He founded it, He built it, and He purchased it! He is our Redeemer, Savior, King and friend. Jesus is everything to a true Christian, because of all of the things He has done for us. Why would we dare name His church after a man or earthly thing? To Him be the glory both now and forever (2 Peter 3:18). May God be praised in all things and may we as Christians be satisfied being His loyal and devoted subjects.

Let's keep in mind how important names and titles are. We must be very careful about using religious names and titles carelessly. Religion should be the most important thing to a child of God, so let's show God we respect Him by using religious names in a proper and Biblical way.
