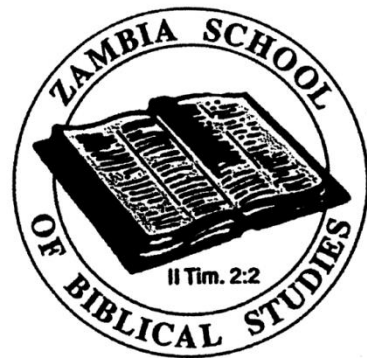

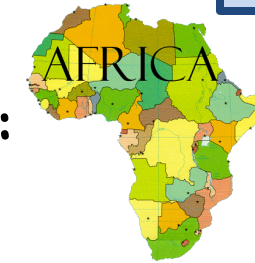

It was truly a great day to see that so much hard work and planning finally paid off. God has really blessed our work in Ghana and we are thankful to Him for His loving kindness.

As far as our graduates, we had 5 graduates from our full-time school and we had 10 graduates from our final Saturday School. That makes over 100 graduates over the years from the Saturday school alone and now 5 graduates for our full-time school. The graduates really seemed excited and ready to get out and use their skills. What a blessing it was to be here in person and to let them know how much we love them and how proud we are of their accomplishment. In all things to God be the glory.

Also, while here, Brent has been busy numbering and cataloging our library. We continue to add to our library and now have over 368 volumes in it. However, we had never cataloged it or numbered the books, so he is doing a great work. Obviously, Matt, Trey and I have pitched in, but he has done most of the work. This will also help us to know what we have, what we are lacking and what we need to make our library more productive for the students and their study experience. Yet another great blessing of God for the good work in Ghana.

I also wanted to again say how thankful I am to brother Mark and Casey for pitching in and helping preach while I am away. I know brother Andy and Brendan will do a great job next week. I also thank brother Gary and you all for your continued support to encourage me and allow me to be involved in our mission efforts as need. I love and appreciate you all! I thank my God upon every remembrance of You!

Finally, please keep us in your prayers as we will be leaving Ghana this Wednesday and be flying to Uganda for the graduation there. It will basically take another two days of travel to arrive at the school in Uganda. Then we will begin our trip home next Monday, arriving home on Wednesday the 21st. We will be in very late but look forward to seeing you all at worship on the 25th.
