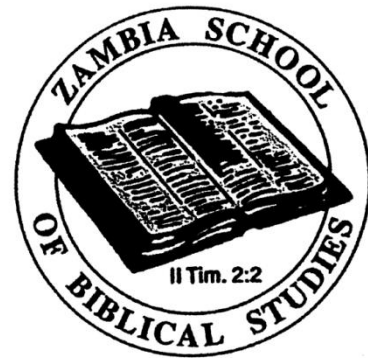

RAY'S REMARKS:



Hello brethren! I hope you are all having a blessed week. This year has started out so well and with so many blessings. I just thank God for each of you as my K.E. Family. You are all truly a gift from God to me.

It's hard to believe but brother Bill and I will be headed to Ghana next Monday. Thank you all for your help and encouragement with these trips. You know I am not crazy about flying so it is a little hard for me to go such a long distance. However, I feel if I am needed in the service of God, I better do all I can. I also know God is in control of all things, so I just have faith that He will always do what is best.

Although I have already talked about the trip in several bulletins, I thought I would take a moment to remind you again of the importance of me going. As you know the school in Ghana is still very young and we have only graduated one intake. Also, our teachers are new to this full-time work and they have many adjustments getting used to the work as well. We are also tripling the size of our class from 5 to 16. All these reasons make it essential that Dad or I go for the start of this intake. We must make sure that things are prepared, started and going smoothly because of the large investment we have in each of these works. Over the last two years we probably have several hundred, thousand dollars invested in this work and all this money is the Lord's and for the Lord's work. We obviously don't want the school to fail, but to succeed, thus it is important that I go and make sure things go well as we begin this second intake. I will also have the privilege of starting the teaching of many of the classes the first week of school, which will also help set a higher standard for instruction in all our classes and from all our teachers. So, I thank you all again for your support, prayers and love as I continue to play a major role in this new work. Together we are doing great things for God and for His Kingdom, in Africa as well as here in the U.S.A. God continues to bless us all as His faithful people.

I look forward to seeing you all tonight, as well as this coming Lord's day. It is always a privilege and honor to gather as God's people and to worship Him. God bless!
