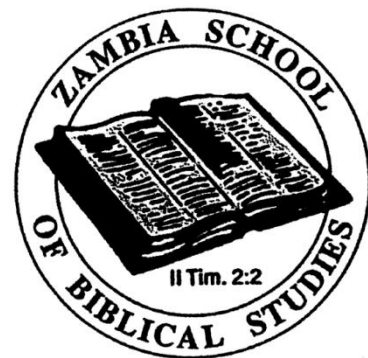

Their purpose for going is to make sure that the next full intake of students begins as scheduled and is properly set up for the next two years. Sixteen students will begin their studies shortly. The school in Ghana has developed now into a full-time school that will provide faithful gospel preachers not only for Ghana but many surrounding countries soon. Our brothers will be back February 2<sup>nd</sup>.

As most of you know, our building was broken into this week on Tuesday morning at 3:10 a.m. The police did come and by using our security cameras we were able to identify the person who broke into our building. He did steal some items but nothing of real importance.

We are sorry we had to cancel the Wednesday evening services but the toxic smell from the fiberglass refinishing of our baptistry was too strong for us to be in the building. Everything should be back to normal by Sunday morning. We now have a baptistry that will last for many years to come. The work had to be done because repairing the leaks no longer worked. Thank you for your understanding.
