The new class really seems engaged and serious about their studies. They seem excited to be here and are really showing themselves ready to learn. I am proud of them all and thankful that they have committed the next two years of their life to studying God's Word. Please pray for these men that the might step up to the challenge and that they might accomplish the ultimate goal of training to become Gospel Preachers for the Lord.

Chapel this week is going well. I always love to hear and see the enthusiasm of our African brethren when they sing praises to God. We have had some great praise offered to God this week in song. We have also had some good chapel lessons presented to challenge our new students. I spoke Monday, Bill spoke yesterday, and brother Henry spoke today. Brother Henry is one of our graduates from last year and the last class here in Ghana. He did a great job and we are very proud of him and his commitment to the cause of Christ.

We were able to get several needs taken care of around the school. We were able to finish the office and move it outside to another room, so that the room we had previously used could be used as a student bedroom. We are also working on getting curtains for all the bedrooms in the school house so that students will have a little more privacy and to help with mosquitos.

It's hard to believe that we will be leaving in just two days, but tomorrow will be another great day of classes, study and fellowship here at the school. Our time here has gone fast, but we have accomplished a lot and I know the school and our new students are on a surer footing for the days ahead over the next few years.

Please pray for Bill and I as we travel back leaving here Friday at 3:30 p.m. and after gaining all of our hours back passing through different time zones we will arrive in Springfield on Saturday at 3:30. Lord willing we will have a safe and peaceful trip home. I love you all and look forward to seeing you Sunday. God bless!

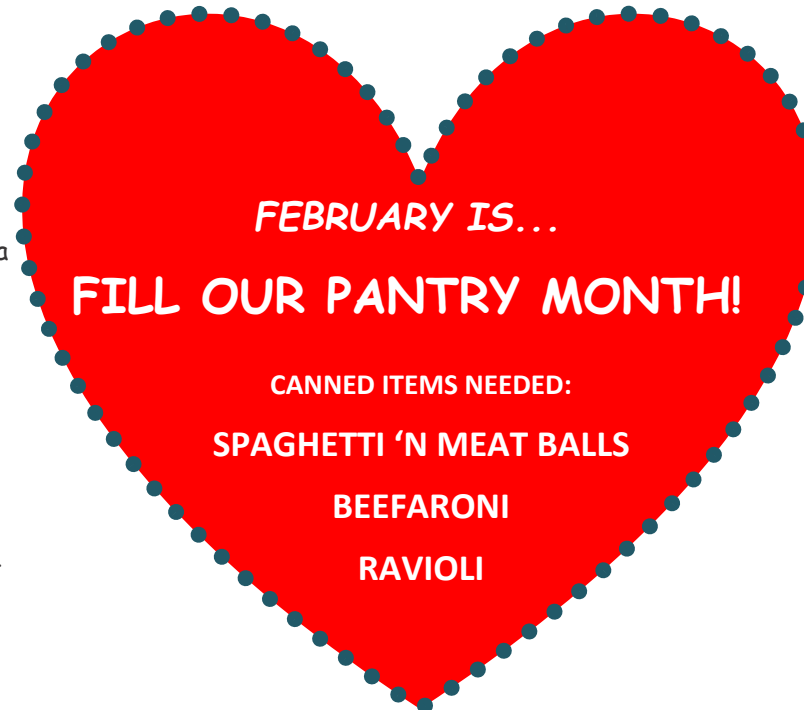

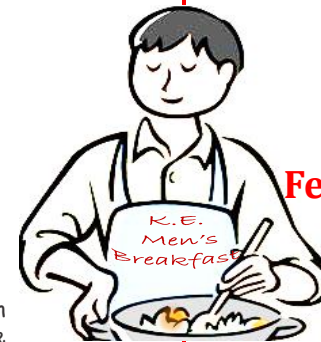
