

K.E. FAMILY LIFELINE



Hello brethren! I hope you are all having a great week. Things are going well in Zambia and God continues to bless our work here daily.

I know that you all are off to a great start with the Gospel Meeting. We appreciate brother Joshua for joining us and helping us to grow in God's Word. I know he is doing a great job and I thank him for helping us out this year with the meeting. I wish I could have been there.

As far as our work here in Zambia. We have been very busy. We arrived last Thursday and began teaching on Friday. Trey has been teaching in the mornings and I am preaching in the afternoon. On Monday, Wednesday and Friday Trey is teaching the book of 1 & 2 Peter; in the afternoon I am teaching Church History and the Preacher and His Work. On Tuesday and Thursdays, Trey is teaching 2 Corinthians and I will be teaching Numbers. We also have been swapping out doing chapel lessons every other morning.

Yesterday was a great Lord's day for us. We got up at 5:00 a.m. and left at 6:00 a.m. to go to the Sikambwe Church of Christ. This congregation is over 3 hours into the bush. It actually took us almost 4 hours to get there on unbelievably bad roads. While at this place we were also able to visit the preachers training school they have started there. It is a part time school; it has already completed the training of 5 men and currently has 10 more in classes from Monday to Wednesday. The name of the school is the Sikalosia Bible School. These brethren have been in a severe drought this year and struggle to get water and food. However, they fed us lunch and it was delicious. We had Shema, chicken, greens, rice and soup. It was a great morning and time to be with these beloved brethren.

After leaving this place around 2 we headed to visit another school about an hour away called the Ngwezi School of Preaching. The congregation which meets at this place is called the Chileya Church of Christ. It took us over 5 hours to get back to Livingstone and it was already dark. Thank God for this good and safe journey and for the time spent with our brethren. By the way, next Saturday, we will be taking another trip back to the same area.

It has been really hot here and the power is off most of the day. We do have a generator in the evenings and the power has been coming on in the late evening. However, we are in good spirits and enjoying the work here.

Well, I pray that you all will be blessed by God in all things and that the Gospel Meeting there will continue to be a success and a glory to God. Please remember Trey and me in your prayers as we continue to work here in Zambia. I love you all and miss you.
