



CAN A PERSON LIVING IN ADULTERY BE BAPTIZED?

Is God willing to forgive every sin? Can a thief, liar, murderer, homosexual, idolater, hater, fornicator, adulterer, drunkard, etc., receive forgiveness? Second Peter 3:9 says, "The Lord...is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." Therefore, a person living in any of these sins can receive forgiveness in baptism IF HE/SHE REPENTS. Water baptism saves (1 Peter 3:21). Sins are washed away in the blood of Jesus at baptism (Revelation 1:5; Acts 22:16).

The KEY to forgiveness of any and all sins is REPENTANCE. Repentance means to change one's mind, to think differently, reconsider.
