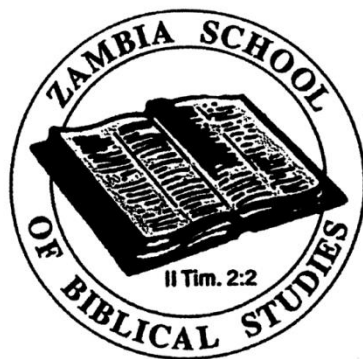

We are doing well and have a lot of great things to report to you concerning the work in Ghana. As always, God has made our trip very prosperous and we have had a healthy and fruitful stay. Please continue to keep us in your prayers as we fly to Europe tonight and to the U.S.A. tomorrow. Finally, we should be arriving, we hope, around 6 pm on Thursday.

We had a great night last night as we had a service with our brothers at the school and some local Christians. It was a farewell service with lots of praise to God songs and many prayers. It is always encouraging to see our brothers and their love for us. Afterwards, we had some chocolate cake which Brent made, which he had brought from the U.S.A. to make for the students. It was a lot of great fun and they really enjoyed it. These men really seem to love each other and to have a lot of fun together. As we know, that is the way that it should be for Christians.

I can't believe how much snow you all have had since we have been gone. I think it has snowed 5 or 6 times and although it's been light, it still snow. You have also had some really cold temperatures. Brent and I are really missing the cooler weather. It has been really hot over here and with the A/C problems having gotten a lot worse, which we didn't really realize until we got here, we had not yet bought a generator for the school. It is one of the things we dealt with while there though. Hopefully, within the next week, we will be able to go ahead and buy a generator for the school. We have already been given the money to do so, I just wish we had gotten it a few weeks earlier.

Finally, I was excited to hear that the Monday night classes are doing so well again. Thanks to all who are participating in person or online. It is great to have such an opportunity available for our Christian growth and even greater that so many are taking advantage of it. May God bless us all as we strive to grow more in His perfect Word!

Well, I hope you have a great Wednesday evening tonight. I wish I could be there with you, but hopefully we will be seeing you all this Sunday. Please keep us in all of your prayers, as I know you do, that we might have a safe journey home over the next two days. Hopefully, the flights will be mainly smooth as well. Love you all! God bless.
