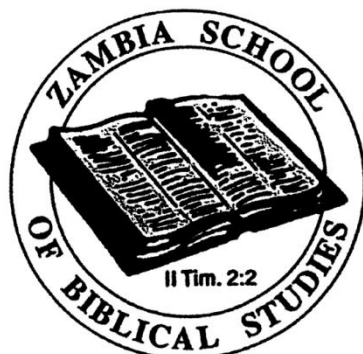

Hello Brethren. Greetings from Aboaso, Ghana. Brent and I arrived safely on Tuesday evening and it was great to see our beloved brothers greeting us at that airport. It was a long and tiring trip, so it was nice to finally be back on the ground and to see some familiar faces.

We also were able to ride in the new school van from the airport. It is very nice and has been a real asset in the work. It has given us a mobility for church work and evangelism which we certainly did not have before. We are thankful to God for this great blessing and know that it is going to assist a lot in accomplishing the work of the Lord here in Ghana.

Well, when we arrived at the school, we had a big surprise. The power was out, and it was completely dark. As most of you know this is a really hot time of the year so it was a little stressful to get here and start off with no power. We weren't able to do a lot except eat when we got here. They had prepared for us a very nice dinner when we arrived and we really enjoyed it, over a flashlight. We Then made our beds and just laid down in the heat to try to keep from sweating, and by the way we couldn't open the windows because of the mosquitoes. We both fell asleep for about an hour then guess what, the power came on. The lights, the AC, the fans, oh yes it was a great blessing. We then got back up and started unpacking some things and finally got ready for bed. We had a great night of rest and are now taking a day to recover before we start teaching and having some faculty meetings and such. We will also be heading out this afternoon (Wednesday) to do some shopping and banking. It usually takes about 2 hours to travel about 15 or 20 miles because of the road and traffic so it will be a little tiring as well, but it will be good to get out and see the sights and such. At least the new van has air conditioning, that will help a lot when you're sitting in traffic in 100-degree temperatures.

Please continue to pray for us as we labor here in Ghana. I know we will accomplish a lot and that God will bless our work here for Him. Thank you all for your prayers and your love in Christ. May God bless us all in His service.

I miss you all and love you. Time goes quickly so we will be home before you know it. See you soon and God bless!
