



Brethren,

The elders are sending you this information concerning our regularly scheduled worship services and gatherings considering the current situation as our country deals with the Corona virus. Please remember:

- 1st It is our duty to worship God and obey Him in all things as His children.
- 2nd -the elders are to guide, care for and protect the flock during all times, that each Christian can be encouraged and be able to worship God and serve him according to His commandments.
- 3rd The corona virus has become a worldwide problem and thus affects us here in Springfield as well. In fact, yesterday both the Springfield City Council and the Greene County Commission issued emergency declarations prohibiting public gatherings of more than 10 people for the next 30 days. The regulations specify that no more than 10 can meet at one time in a single room or confined area but do allow for gatherings of more than 10 people in separate rooms/areas.
- 4th Christians are to obey local authorities and rulers as long as they allow us to do what is in keeping with God's will.

Accordingly, the elders have made the following decisions regarding our regular times of worship and Bible study. We make these changes, on a temporary basis, in order to fulfill our duty to God and, at the same time, comply with the laws of the land:

ALL SERVICES AND BIBLE CLASSES WILL AVAILABLE ONLINE ONLY VIA: STREAMING FROM OUR WEBSITE OR THROUGH FACEBOOK LIVE ON OUR FACEBOOK PAGE!

Our Wednesday night classes/services will be held on-line only at this time. We encourage you to join online on Wednesday evenings at 7 pm to participate in a bible class with the K.E. family.

Also, BIM Monday night classes will continue online only for the time being. Classes are at 6:30 & 7:30 pm.

On Sundays, we will continue to have our regular Sunday morning bible class at 9:30 a.m. and our 10:30 a.m. worship service, online only. The Sunday afternoon worship service has been cancelled for the time being, but we encourage you to watch archived lessons or services through our website.

We also give the following suggestions:

- 1. We encourage you to continue worshiping God regularly by joining online for each opportunity of study or worship.
- 2. Please make sure to get some grape juice (100%) and some crackers (unleavened bread) to keep at home, in case at some point we are only able to go to online services and streaming. That way we could still worship together online, and you would have what you need to partake of the Lord supper on the first day of the week. (proper crackers are not always easy to find, so make sure and check the label on crackers. many have leaven or yeast in them).
- 3. Please, remember that Christians are also commanded to give on the first day of every week. So, make sure and send your contribution in by mail or drop it off at the church building or BIM during the week when someone is present, or plan to make up when we return to our to normal worship together.
- 4. If you are having difficulty getting online, or getting the necessary grape juice or unleavened bread, please let us know and we will be able to assist you. We have plenty of supplies at the building and at the BIM.
