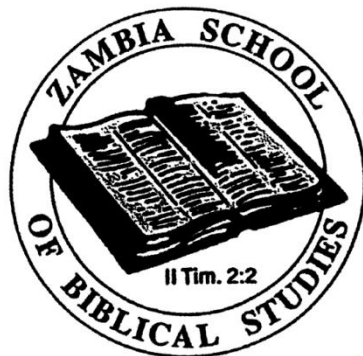

ELDERS' CORNER:

Last week, we had the privilege to present to the congregation our 2020 budget which included the loan that will be made to provide the funds necessary for needed repairs to our roof as well as some repairs on the inside of our building. Our budget for 2020 is \$4,622 per week. A challenge was given to us all to increase our weekly contributions to meet our budget. In order to maintain our weekly commitment, we will need to raise an additional \$265.00 per week which excludes 5th Sunday contributions. Actually, since the first of the year we have maintained an average of around \$4,500 a week. So, our goal is reachable by an effort on the part of us all. As stated, we will be viewing our weekly contributions for 90 days to see if we can maintain \$4,622 per week before any action is made to make any cuts in the works we are supporting at this time. We believe we will not have to make those cuts.

Also mentioned in our presentation was a need to take care of a note that was made over the past few years to make necessary repairs on our building and take care of expenses for the Living Word Broadcast. The amount of the loan is: \$42,462. We have challenged the congregation to make a special effort on March 29 to retire this debt so that we will reduce the funds needed to make the repairs on our roof. We realize it is a lot to raise in a short time, but many have expressed a desire to help in retiring this debt. The request being made was suggested by our Finance Committee that has worked hard to help us to formulate a budget that will take care of the needs this coming year in a responsible manner. Let us all do our part to help with the needs of our family here at K.E. If you have any further questions, please feel free to ask either of us or both of us together. May God bless us as we strive to maintain our work here at K.E.
