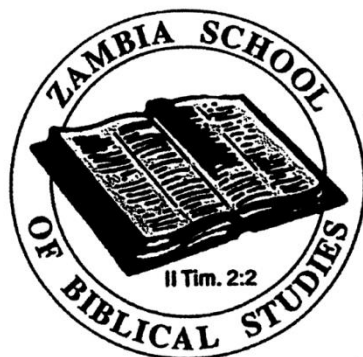

Also remember that we are going to have a special 5th Sunday contribution at the end of this month to come up with a lump sum to either use to cover an existing loan or to go toward the new roof. Let's continue to do God's work together and accomplish as much as we can. Praise be to God for our privilege to serve Him.

We are starting our final quarter of classes at the BIM. This quarter I will be teaching New Testament Greek 4 and the book of Revelation. I am looking forward to a great quarter and a wrapping up with this class with these studies with us. We pray that our students will continue to do well and finish out their studies in a good way. Please keep all these men in your prayers as they continue to focus on the things of God and consider and work toward their futures in the work of the Lord.

Well, I look forward to seeing you tonight for our mid-week service. How wonderful it will be to gather as God's people and to worship before his mighty throne. May God bless us all in His daily service.

ELDERS' CORNER:

Thank you to the congregation for answering the call this past Sunday! We presented our 2020 budget to the membership on March 1st and challenged you to increase our giving. The target we gave you was \$4,622. Our contribution was over \$5,200 last Sunday! Thank you for your commitment to meeting this goal and helping us maintain our mission focus while also meeting our current physical needs for the building. Purpose in your hearts to maintain this level of giving. As we told the congregation, if we are able to meet our \$4,622 weekly goal for the next 90 days, we will commit to maintaining our current mission expenditures. If we don't, or if our contribution falls below the target, we will be forced to cut back on our mission work.

Remember also our March 2020 5th Sunday special contribution. Our goal is \$42,462, which represents Kansas Expressway's portion of an existing loan with the BIM. If we can reach this goal, we can then reduce the congregation's responsibility and allow BIM funds to be used to pay the remainder of the loan.

Remember those, especially of our number, in your prayers who are having challenges with their health. Be thankful in your prayers to our Father for the many answered prayers and the blessings He continually bestows on us.

We rejoice that Daniel Simon has put on Christ in baptism. Pray for his lifelong service in the Lord's kingdom.
