

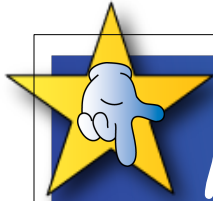

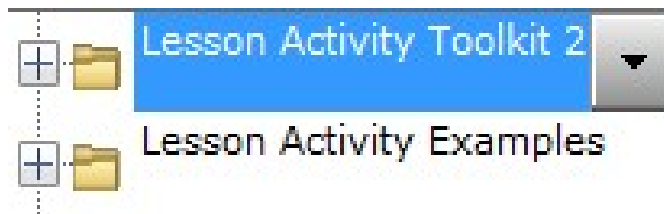


- Major categories with subfolders
