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Rules, Regulations & Policies

The purpose of Happy Tails Day Camp and Pet Care is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for dogs. All dogs wishing to join our camp will be evaluated at an initial consultation (free of charge). To ensure the safety and health of your dog and our other campers, we require all campers to comply with the following:

AGE: All dogs must be at least 6 months of age or older.

SEX: All dogs 6 months or older must be spayed or neutered.

VACCINES: All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. These include the Rabies, Bordetella (kennel cough). Please provide proof of your pet's vaccinations with this application.

FLEA/TICK: All dogs must be kept on regular flea/tick control program. Any dog found to have fleas will be treated with Nexgard by the staff at the Guardian's expense.

BEHAVIOR: All dogs must be non-aggressive and not be food or toy protective. Guardians will certify their dogs have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember, your pet will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our main concern. We do offer dog walking services for dogs unable to attend our day camp.

ATTENDANCE: Dogs approved for day camp will commit to an agreed upon schedule and be required to give Happy Tails two weeks notice for cancellation of participation. We will always try and cover unforeseen absences. If we are able to, you will be credited on your next invoice. Dogs who have previously attended day camp but have not attended for an extended period of time, may require an evaluation before being readmitted.

DAYS & HOURS: Daycare is currently offered Monday through Friday with a morning play group and an afternoon play group. Morning pick up is between 9:00 - 10:00 a.m. with drop off between 11:30 - 12:00, afternoon pick up is between 12:00 - 1:00 with drop of between 2:30 - 3:00. Overnight care is offered on a case by case basis.

RESERVATIONS: All dogs admitted into day camp will agree to a committed schedule and be required to give Happy Tails two weeks notice for cancellation of participation. We will always try and cover unforeseen absences and if we are able to you will not be charged.

PAYMENT: Clients will be invoiced monthly or at time of pick up for overnight stays. We accept Cash or Check. Checks will be made payable to Rachael Jaquay. A \$25 fee is charged for any check returned due to non-sufficient Funds.

WEATHER: Weather permitting Happy Tails will provide services. However, in circumstances of extremely cold temperatures (below zero) , Happy Tails will continue to provide services by coming to your home for ½ hour to play with your dog and let them out to go to the bathroom. During icy conditions unsafe for Happy Tails to travel, Happy Tails will call to notify you of any changes. Arrangements will be made by Happy Tails to credit you for the services missed dues to weather.
