## King Jesus Prayed for .... John 17

## **Background information:**

- Although the model prayer that Jesus prayed in response to one of his disciple's request that Jesus teach them how to pray is commonly referred to as "The Lord's Prayer," that prayer is an example of how prayer may be done rather than an example of how Jesus typically prayed.
- There are several different kinds of prayers: (A few common examples are listed below)
  - o corporate prayers that invoke and/or invite God to take an active role in the worshipping community (invocation)
  - o prayers requesting God to deliver, protect and/or provide for you and yours (personal petition)
  - o prayers for God to act on behalf of someone else (intercessory)
  - o prayers to let God know you appreciate what God has done (thanksgiving)
