

Real Questions Bible Study II: “How Can I Be Sure God Exists?” – Psalm 19:1-14

Opening Questions

- 1) What are some other experiences that people might have that might convince them that God couldn't possibly exist (or that a loving & caring God couldn't possibly exist)?

- 2) What are some different ways for people to get to know each other? Which ways do you think are most effective?

Into the Text

- 1) Verses 1 and 2 reveal that creation testifies about God in at least four ways. What are the four ways and which if any remind you that God not only exists but cares for creation? (If none of these testimonies remind you that God exists AND cares, what testimony does?)

- 2) Our lesson today reminds us that God has given us a variety of ways to get to know God. Which of the ways of getting to know God have you neglected to use and why?

- 3) How does today's lesson support that idea that we CAN know something about God even though we can't PROVE what we know to other people?

- 4) Think about the things that God has revealed to you so far concerning who and how God is. What impresses you the most? Why is this so impressive?

- 5) The psalmist in today's lesson ends his testimony about how getting to know God has blessed him with a special request. Now it's your turn. What would you like God to help you do so that you can know God more?
