Governing Body Delegations

The Governing Body delegates to a Resources Committee and a Curriculum & Standards Committee (Standing Committees) in accordance with the Terms of Reference for those committees. In addition the Governing Body may meet to discharge its functions in respect of Performance Management, Admissions, Exclusions, Disciplinary (ad hoc committees).

This governing body will not delegate the following functions:

- the alteration, discontinuance or change of category of the school
- the approval of the first formal budget plan of the financial year
- setting the admissions policy and oversubscription criteria annually
- the suspension of governors.

The governing body cannot delegate any functions relating to:

- the constitution of the governing body (unless otherwise provided by the Constitution Regulations 2012)
- the appointment or removal of the chair and vice-chair
- the delegation of functions
- the establishment of committees
- staffing matters unless otherwise provided by the School Staffing (England) Regulations 2009
- making and reviewing a written statement of principles which the headteacher must have regard to when determining the behaviour policy

The governing body can still perform functions it has delegated, enabling it to make decisions on matters that may usually be dealt with by a specific committee.
