TTCC donated \$800 so that Montrose Ford could give a new truck to a combat wounded veteran. In an article in the Akron Beacon Journal dated January 9, 2016:

"Montrose Ford in Fairlawn gave a new Ford F150 XLT Super Crew to Joshua Sust, 28 from Cincinnati, a retired Marine who lost his left foot in Afghanistan. Montrose raised \$37,000 last year in their fundraisers and donations with the money going to "Wounded Warriors Family Support's Mobility is Freedom" program.

Montrose raised the most money of any participated dealership in the United States, more than that of any other Ford dealership."

In mid-December, GM filed paperwork with the United States Patent and Trademark Office to Trademark the name "E-Ray" and "Corvette E-Ray."
