2017 CONVENTION IS BACK ON IN BOWLING GREEN, KY

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as prepared.

FCOA is going well with 2,413 members. Kids can age out at age 16. Parents need to make sure NCCC has their corrected address.

NCCC has 18,290 members and 249 Clubs

East Ohio Region has 1,160 member and 33 members at large.

Treasurer gave the Treasurer report.

EOR By-law Changes

Proposed By-Law changes for the EOR.

1. One of the changes is that the Secretary and Treasurer positions be separate.
2. Rather than electing all five Officers in the same year, it has been proposed the RCD, RMD and Secretary shall be elected in the even year for a two year term and the RE and Treasurer be elected in the odd year, for a two year term.

A copy of the By-Laws and changes will be made available for anyone interested.

Head Tax

It has been proposed that the EOR head tax be increased from \$2 to \$3 or possibly \$5 to help fund the Jeanne Kutty Scholarship Fund which must maintain a minimum amount of \$2000 and any extra will go to the General Fund.

East Ohio Region Hall of Fame

It was proposed that a nominee can be put on the ballot for two consecutive years without a nomination form being filled out again, if the nominee is not inducted into the Hall of Fame after the second year they will not be put back on the ballot. They can be re-nominated after two years have passed.

Charity of choice for NCCC is now St. Jude Hospital.

Nationally 18 Clubs have submitted their Clubs newsletter for the Newsletter contest.

Anyone taking a delivery of a new Corvette at the Corvette Museum is given a one free membership to any Club in National Council. NCCC has signed up 191 new members.
