President's Report

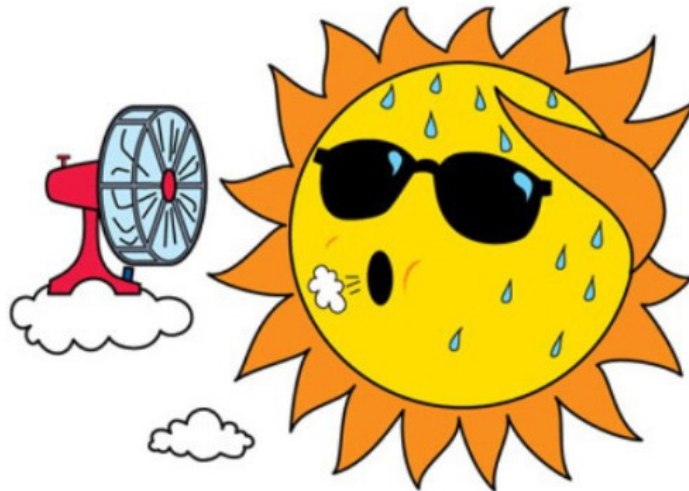
