Drawing will be November 12th at the St. Louis Governors meeting. The proceeds will go to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital

FOCA (Future Corvette Owners Assc.) has 2284 members. NCCC members have been supporting the FCOA for 25 years. The cost is a one-time membership fee of \$10. Applications are available on the NCCC web site.

Convention 2017 will be at Bowling Green, KY. President, Dave Heinemann has asked anyone attending the banquet at convention to dress up.

Proposed for 2018 is New Orleans, LA and there are two possible bids for 2019.

NCCC will not be sending out new Membership cards each year. Your card will now be good for 5 years. A date sticker will be mailed to you when you renew each year and that will go on the NCCC Membership card you have.

Listed below are the seven National By-Law changes. If anyone has any objections to any of these changes, please contact me.

NATIONAL - PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

1. Add Convention Treasurer as a member of Finance Committee
2. Add appointed position of Director of IT and list general Duties
3. Remove only one member per Club restriction for Executive Board membership
4. Establish the position of Co-Director of Convention
5. Expand Duties of Directory of Charity position
6. Expand acceptable Dates for Convention to April 1st to November 1st

EAST OHIO REGION

Head tax will go up to \$5.00 in 2018

Sanction Fees will stay the same

Majority voted to end the Jeanne Kutty scholarship fund at the end of the year. The Region will make a \$1000 donation at the end of this year and that will be the last.

Bids for 2017 Sanctions will be at the next Regional meeting on December 3rd, 2016. The Region is asking each Club to donate one sanction and pay the sanction fee in 2017 to be used at the Regional events at the Corvette Museum in September 2017.

Steve and Sue Hamilton have volunteered to host the 2016 Regional banquet March 4th which will be a sit down dinner. Mark the date on your calendar and when more info is given it will be posted in the Club Newsletter.

RCD – Al Flanhofer was voted to be Regional RCD for the next two years.

RMD - Cheryl Getzy was voted to be Regional Membership for the next two years.

I have copies of the Regional Treasurer's report as of 9/7/16

The Region is proposing a Regional Monument to be placed at the Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery near Rittman, OH to be placed in the memorial garden walkway. This would be funded by donations from Clubs or individuals. There will be no raffles or fund raising for the memorial. It is still in the planning stages. Anyone wanting more information this see me.

Ladies and Gentleman.

I want to propose a Regional Monument to be placed at the



Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery near Rittman, OH.

If you have never been there I recommend a visit, as a retired member of the military, I take great pride in what the Veterans Administration (VA) is offering all members of all military service.

A while back I took Allen Selders to the cemetery; Al is a Purple Heart member. As we were walking around the memorial gardens, we heard the 21 gun salute, then taps being played and to top it off Bag pipes being played. This my friends made your hair stand up. I told Allen that we should consider a memorial to service members, current and past that were Corvette owners. As with lots of ideas and dreams it was put on hold. About a month ago I woke up with this super strong urge to make it happen.

I have contacted the cemetery, the local memorial engraver, and most of all the Regional Executive. (RE) Presented my ideas to Terry, and he stated, great idea and move forward with it. Bring it to the board of Governors, Don Obert has offered to be my liaison. (Corvette Cleveland).

This would be an East Ohio Region presentation; all 14 clubs will be included, not any one separately. The funding will come from the East Ohio Region; if a club wants to contribute, then the money must pass through the Region. No fund raiser or raffle, this must be maintained the highest respect for our fallen and current service members.

The memorial garden is a walkway through the woods with many memorials in place. There is a scatter area in the walkway for family's to spread the ashes. Any member and spouse can be interred there. Some of the memorials are from Rolling Thunder, American Legion, AmVets, K of C, VFW, and many more.

I know this is in the planning stages, but I need a show of interest before I can move forward. I told the cemetery manager we could put over 200 Corvettes in the cemetery for the unveiling, two Cleveland TV stations have done news clips from there, Leon Bibbs the most recent.

The cost at this time could run as high as \$10,000 but trying to stay under \$5,000.

This project could take six months to a year for VA approval.
