

Nicklaus Joint Venture Group

The *Nicklaus Joint Venture Group* was appointed Wirral Council's chosen developer for the proposed Hoylake Golf Resort in 2015.

Despite its name, Jack Nicklaus is not a shareholder. He has no direct links with the Group.

There are five directors, one of whom is an employee of Jack Nicklaus but holds no shares in the Group. The majority shareholder has been a director of many companies most of which have been dissolved or liquidated. One of these companies, since liquidated, built the homes on the Machynys Peninsular Golf Club & Premier Spa.

This director has been promising to bring a 4* hotel to Llannelli but five years later it has not arrived.

NJVG was formed, on the basis of £1,000-worth of shares, in September 2014 with six directors, one of whom has since resigned.

Three active directors are shareholders along with £50-worth being held by a Nicklaus nominee company.
