A Call To Pray

- **Perilous Times – 2 Timothy 3:1**
- **chalepós**, khal-ep-os'; perhaps from through the idea of reducing the strength; difficult, i.e. dangerous, or (by implication) furious:—fierce, perilous [crazy, confused, perverted, trying---tgc]
- Every storm is reportedly worse
- The solution I would that men pray everywhere **1Timothy 2:1-8**

A Call To Pray

- **Jonah 1**
- Jonah was running from his assignment
- The ship was carrying people / mariners from different places cultures/each man call upon (prayed to) his god
- (Note: gods & communication—define culture)
- A storm arose
- In the world storms affect all the inhabitants of the earth
- This one was because of Jonah
- But Jonah / the Church was asleep
- **Call on (pray to) your God**

A Call To Pray

- 1 Kings 18:19-39
- Contest on Carmel
- The prophets of Baal called on/prayed to Baal
- Baal – the god of the land
- Elijah -- My God is Jehovah or Yehovah is God
- Elijah called on / prayed to God Almighty – Yahweh / YeHovah

What is prayer?

- **Prayer first denotes** -----
- 1. Reliance**---acknowledges help is needed/we are not self sufficient
- come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and grace for help
- come boldly and obtain/new living way Hebrews
- Now unto him that is able to keep---Jude
- 2 Chronicles 7:14---result of Solomon's prayer 6:13-42

What is prayer?

2. Communication----when you pray -- say—Mark 11/Mathews 6 /

- Seeking God—Psalms 63 (whole chapter) early will I seek thee---**connecting**
 - Talking to God---1 Corinthians 14:2 **speake**th to God/John 11:40-42 Father I than you hear me
 - Listening to God---(Habakkuk 2:1) I will send upon my watch and see what he will say/
 - John10—My sheep know my voice/ Romans 8:14 led by the Spirit / 1 John 2:20 Unction and we know--
 - Agreeing with God---Amos 3:3 / Matthew 18:19, 20
 - Speaking for God – I’ve given you the keys----prophets/James 5--Elijah prayed that concerning rain
 - Fellowship with God---1 John 1 / Psalms 8----God visits us /john 14:21 Jesus will manifest
- Note --- Everything must be according to scripture---1 Timothy --so the Man of God may be thoroughly furnished

First Mentioned

- [Genesis 4:26](#) And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: **then began men to call** upon the name of the Lord---
- 26 To Seth, also, a son was born, whom he named **Enosh (mortal man, mankind)**. At that [same] time men began to **call** on the name of the **Lord** [in worship through prayer, praise, and thanksgiving]. **Genesis 4:26 (AMP)**
- Enosh – Man
- Lord – Yehovah
- A revelation of the name of God pre - Moses
- **Call**--- **qârâ’**, kaw-raw’; a primitive root (rather identical with [H7122](#) through the idea of accosting a person met); to call out to (i.e. properly, address by name, but used in a wide variety of applications):—bewray (self), that are bidden, call (for, forth, self, upon), cry (unto), (be) famous, guest, **invite**, mention, (give) name, **preach**, (make) proclaim(-ation), pronounce, **publish**, read, renowned, say---invoke
- God name first used in Worship
- Eve doesn’t use reference to God (the Creator) in Worship ---she use Elohim (Gen 3:3)

Hebrew /OT

- **Primary**--- t^ephillâh, tef-il-law'; from [H6419](#); intercession, supplication; by implication, a hymn:—prayer.
- Refers to---praying, place of prayer, tiles of prayer
- Others
- lachash, lakh'-ash; from [H3907](#); properly, a whisper, i.e. by implication, (in a good sense) a private prayer, (in a bad one) an incantation; concretely, an amulet:—charmed, earring, enchantment, orator, prayer.
- châlah, khaw-law'; a primitive root properly, to be rubbed or worn; hence (figuratively) to be weak, sick, afflicted; or (causatively) to grieve, make sick; also to stroke (in flattering), **entreat**:—**beseech**, (be) diseased, (put to) grief, be grieved, (be) grievous, infirmity, intreat, lay to, put to pain, × pray, make prayer, be (fall, make) sick, sore, be sorry, make suit (× supplication), **woman in travail**, be (become) weak, be wounded---Daniel 9:13.

Greek / NT

- **Primary**---proseuché, pros-yoo-khay'; --4335 from [G4336](#); prayer (worship); by implication, an oratory (chapel):—X pray earnestly, prayer----**emphases on a place of prayer**—synagogue / special place
- ---Luke 22:45 Gethsemane
- déēsis, deh'-ay-sis; 1162----from [G1189](#); a petition:—prayer, request, supplication need, indigence, want, privation, penury / a seeking, asking, entreating, entreaty to God or to man
- Ephesians 6:18 / Phillipians 4:4

Teach us to pray

- Luke 11:1 / Mathews 6---**Teach us how to pray**---like John teaches his disciples
- Matthew 10:25 it is good for a disciple to be as his master/teacher
- [Luke 6:40](#)--The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be as his master.

- **Why the Questions?**

Why did they have to ask Jesus?

- He was already teaching by example
- The Father was with them
- **He Answers---Jesus gives example / a structure / of prayer**

The Lord's Prayer---Structure

- Our Father---God is the source—the center of focus / be holy as I am holy
- Who art in heaven- Gods seat / heaven / not a statue / bot a concept
- Hallowed be thy name – the things of God/ connection with him is holy – sanctified—Jesus said there is only one way to the Father
- Thy Kingdom come—Gods way of doing things – his word
- Thy will be done – the sovereign one uphold his own word – his word is not detached from him / his word is truth
- On earth as it is in heaven – not only the model – but image – no hindrance there and its code is enforceable on earth – the word has the same authority in both places --- satan had to obey God there

The Lord's Prayer---Structure

- Give us this day our daily bread – trusting God is relational as well as in principle and authority
- And forgive us our debt / sin / trespasses as we forgive our ---- the trigger or the power does not rest on the earth side – Christ was crucified before the foundations of the world – but the sinner can not enter in until he receives by enter in that same love of God given
- Lead us not into temptation --- God doesn't lead us into temptation- so it is to keeps us from it
- Deliver from all evil – we can believe God for this
- For thine is the kingdom ---- Again Lord you are the source
- The Power --- not our own strength
- The Glory – the victor traces/ links back to/ flows from / God
- Forever --- God will never change --- his the stability of all creation

Structure Part 2-Importunity / Intercession

- Luke 11
- **Confidence in prayer /importunity/I'm on the roof until someone helps me**
- Friend at midnight
- Importunity **the state of being** overly persistent in request or demand
- **Luke 18 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;**
- Luke 18:2-8 woman before the unrighteous judge
- **Another Example----**
- John 11:41-42---Jesus said Father I thank you that you hear me
- Hebrews 4:16 / 1:19, 20---having boldness

Structure Part 3--Importunity / Intercession

- 1 John 5:14, 15---we have this confidence
- Mark 11:22-25 --- what so ever you ask the father
- Mathew 7:7-12 and Mark 11:22-24 ---**ASK** mantra of scripture --- **Ask Seek Knock**
- Missing it---James 4:3
- Amiss---**kakōs**, kak-ōce'; from [G2556](#); badly (physically or morally):—amiss, diseased, evil, grievously, miserably, sick, sore. improperly, wrongly
- **Consume**---**dapanāō**, dap-an-ah'-o; from [G1160](#); to expend, i.e. (in a good sense) to incur cost, or (in a bad one) to waste:—be at charges, consume, spend.
- Lust—sinful desires

Crucial Elements of Prayer

- Faith --- have faith in God / doubt not Mark 11:23-25 / Hebrews 11:1-6
- Trust – trust in the Lord with all you heart and lean not to your own understanding—Proverbs 3:5
- Blood consciousness – we come boldly to the throne of grace— Hebrews 10
- Jesus is the High Priest of our confession---Hebrews 3:1 / 4:14
- Righteousness – the fervent & effectual prayer of a righteous man— James 5:13-19
- Elements of Mark 11:23-25

The P's of Prayer

Power of Prayer

- Bind and loose Matthews 18
- James 5---any sick among you
- Now unto Him who is able to keep us from falling--- Jude
- Psalms 149---we bind up the enemies
- Jude - Pull people out of the fire
- Proverbs 31---to speak for those who are dumb

The P's of Prayer

Place of Prayer

- Psalms 100:4 I will enter His gates with thanksgiving in my heart
- (Place of heart) Philippians 4:6--Be anxious for nothing but in everything- by prayer and supplication
- Exodus 20:24 In every place where I cause my name to be remembered I will come to you and bless you.
- Matthew 18:20: For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them.
- Find your---Wilderness/ Gethsemane/mountain ---Mt Olive /Ziklag/
River Chebar/ Patmos

The P's of Prayer

Position of Prayer---physical & spiritual

- Upper room—sitting (Physically)
- Holy hands lifted—1 Timothy 2:8
- **Prostrate / bow**
- Ephesians 6:13, 14—standing
- Ephesians 2:6--Seated together with Him---we're not trying to break the clouds or bombard heaven
- Matthew 5:24 -- Reconciliation --- Leaving you gift at the altar
- Psalms 66:18 if I regard---God will not hear
- Without faith it is impossible to please God---Hebrews 11:6
- He that comes must first believe that He is---and a rewarder—diligence
- Before the throne---Hebrews 4:16

The P's of Prayer

Path of prayer---where the lifestyle leads

- This is the will of God 1 Thessalonians 5:18 / Philippians 4:6
- Gethsemane –not my will---Luke 22:42
- God will give the desires of our heart – desires must be based on the Word
- **1 Thessalonians 5:17, 25---pray for us**

The P's of Prayer

Patience & Prevail of prayer

- Let Patience – have her perfect work---James 1:4
- Hebrews 10:23 - Hold forth the profession of our faith without wavering – for he is faithful
- **Tenacity – in intercession – Dr. Shivers article**

The P's of Prayer

Purpose of Prayer

- Come boldly—obtain mercy & grace for help
- Fellowship---1 John 1-9
- Bind & loose---Psalms 149
- Examination---1 Corinthians 11:28 / **communion table**
- Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates? [2 Corinthians 13:5](#)
- [Psalm 19:12](#)--Who can understand his errors? cleanse thou me from secret faults.
- [Psalm 51:2, 7](#) --Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.
- The Lord turned the captivity of Job when he prayed for his friends---42:10
- Supplications / petition
- 1 Corinthians 14:2(1-19)---speak / **prays in tongues talks to God**

The P's of Prayer

Practice of Prayer

- **When** you pray---Matthews 6:5 / Mark 11:24, 25 faith, forgive
- First of all prayer----1 Timothy 2:1
- Mathews 6:11 / Luke 11:3---Daily Bread
- Early will I seek thee---Psalms 63
- Acts 2:46 continued daily in the temple

The P's of Prayer

Pursuit of Prayer

- Psalms 63---my soul longs for thee / As I have seen thy power in the sanctuary
- Song of Solomon----look for the beloved

3 Governments of - Prayer

- Classification to help
- The Government shall rest upon His shoulder---Isaiah 9:6
- **These 3 elements should be in every intercessory based prayer**
- **Executive / Judicial /Legislative**

3 Governments of - Prayer

- **Executive**---exercise authority –bind & loose – /decree & declare---Job 22:28
- Jesus cursed the fig tree---no man shall eat off of you— Mark 11:14--- And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. **And his disciples heard it.**
- Father in Jesus name I exercise / execute the authority you have given me
- **Judicial** --- pray what the Word say about the situation—the Word is the judge – Hebrew 4
- Father according to your Word this situation is a symptom of the curse but according to Galatians 3:12-15 Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law
- **Legislative** – make a stand upon the Word / patience / steadfast 1Peter 5:9, Hebrews 6:19, / unmovable 1 Cor 15:58 /politics are in heaven---Philippians 3:20- / I Am confessions / write it down---
- I am the healed despite of what the situation says
- **Give a prayer example that includes all 3 branches**

Contract of Contact—initiating Government

- Women with the Issue of Blood
- **She said** – if I ---can touch the Hem / Him of His garment—Mark 5:28
- Jacob wrestle with the angel until—Genesis 32:24-30
- Could also be a place of obedience---Go wash in Siloam—John 9:1-15
- Could be a place of resolution

Powers of prayer

- Exusia – blood of Jesus authority
- Dunamis---HS Power/miracle working
- Traditional – non effect
- Fellowship of Prayer
- Divine Will----according to His will—Faith begins where the will of God is known
- Rhema / Logos

The Armor of Prayer

- **Ephesian 6:10-18**
- Having done all to stand
- The military position ---
- Each piece
- **2 Corinthians 10:3-6** We wrestle not against flesh and blood
- The weapons of our warfare / not carnal/ **mighty-through God** /pulling down strongholds/ **casting down imaginations**

Everything is not prayer

- Traditions of men—Matthew 15:6
- **Heathens think they will be heard by their much speaking—Matthew 6:7**
- Hoping and praying---without faith it is impossible
- Is it According to scripture---
- **building the house on the sayings of Jesus / Matthew 7:24-29**
- Isaiah 55 ---God's Word will not return Void
- The angels hearken unto the Word of God—Psalms 103:20
- **out of the mouth of two or three witnesses—2Cor 13:1**
- Ask and have not---consume it upon lust---James 4:3
- All who say Lord, Lord won't enter in—Matthew 7:21

Release in Prayer

- **Amen**—So be it /agreement/make the sustenance of what was said your own
- 1 Corinthians 14:16 / 2 Corinthians 1:20
- **The prayer of faith** (Not prayer of unbelief) will save the sick---
---**James 5:15**

Removing the Obstacles

- Mark 11:25 –When you pray forgive
- Leave your gift at the altar---Matthews 5:23, 24
- How long has he been like this? Mark 9:14-29
- And the secrets of his heart revealed---1 Corinthians 14

Prayer & Fasting

Isaiah 58

- When you fast—Matthews 6:16
- These kind come out---Mark 9:28, 29
- The fasted life
- What do I fast?
- **The Daniel Fasts (2)**
- 10 day Cleanse/ sanctification---Daniel 1:12 Pulse and Water---God gave them wisdom
- ¹⁷ As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.
- Daniel 10:1-3 (1-12)---Answer to vision and intercession---seemingly aided in spiritual warfare³
- I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

The Name of Jesus in Prayer

- Importance---definition
- Iēsoûs, ee-ay-sooce'; of Hebrew origin ([H3091](#)); Jesus (i.e. Yehoshua), Joshua—Jesus.
- yesh-oo'-aw; something saved, i.e. (abstractly) deliverance; hence, aid, victory, prosperity:—deliverance, health, help(-ing), salvation, save, saving (health), welfare. Salvation /deliverance
- **Given /Reserved/Decreed**
- No other name **given** whereby we must —Act 4:12
- You shall call his name Jesus---Matthew 1:21
- **Obtained –Conquest**
- Philpians 2:4-11---wherefore Gods has given him a name
- Every knee must bow

The Name of Jesus in Prayer

- **Position**---God has highly exalted him and given --- Philpians 2:4-11
- **Address**---at the name of Jesus/whole family is named---Ephesians 3:14-15
- **Apostolic Authority / Authority – backing**
 - --Mark 16:17 These sign shall follow them that believe in my name---
 - John 14: 13---Whatsoever you ask the Father in my name
 - Romans 10:13---Whosoever shall call on the name

Major and Minor Prayers of Scripture

- Prayer of Moses---Psalms 90
- Abraham – prayer for Sodom & Gomorrah---Genesis 18:19-33
- Joshua into battle---Joshua 1-6 The Lord is constantly speaking to Joshua/advancement—sin & obedience at Ai---Joshua is now praying to God---7:6-9
- Jacob’s wrestling prayer Genesis 32:24-32
- Gideon’s Prayers

- 1 Kings 18:36, 37---Fire from heaven / judgment/ confirmation/God be glorified
- Jesus at Lazarus tomb---John 11
- Blind man from birth --- that I might see---Mark 10:51, 52

Major and Minor Prayer of Scripture

- Paul remove this thorn---2 Corinthians 12:7-9
- Acts 4:24-30 prayer – in the name of your Holy child
- Paul & Silas – at midnight Acts 16:25, 26
- Prayer was made without ceasing for Peter by the church—
- Acts 12:5-7
- **Jesus ever lives to make intercession for us---Hebrews 7:25**

An Observation of Scripture

- **Observation of Scripture**
- There is no record of Adam--the son of God in prayer of fellowship with the Father
- Before the Fall – he pronounces over his wife (decree and declare)
- After the fall he states – his condition – I was *naked and afraid*

4 Types Prayers--Summarized

- **1 Timothy 2**---I exhort therefore, that, first of all, **supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks**, be made for all men;
- 1. **Supplications**—Specifics (request) maybe daily list/goals
- 2. **Prayers**—general/fellowship/making mention
- 3. **Intercessions**—standing in the gap/may be for a situation of need not known by the person you are praying for /kingly/priestly—territorial/-protection
- 4. **Giving of Thanks**---appreciation/honor/acknowledgement of God's person, work, intervention, opens the door for miracles

More On Prayer---petition vs. supplication

- **Supplication**—*těchinnah* tek·in·nä—prayer for favor 1 Kings 8:28, 30/*deēsis* de'-ā-sēs-to entreat, seeking, asking, --for a need, penury—Ephesians 6:18, Philpians 4:6
- **Petition--OT usage only** kjv--translate to ask in NT (but seen also in Luke 18)
Ester 5:8 If I have found favour in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my **petition**, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do tomorrow as the king hath said.
- **shě'elah sheh·ā·lä'** – a thing asked for, request, demand

More On Prayer

Prayer Traditions

- *Prayer of Comfort* and other traditional prayers—can be placed in several other categories
- We **pray for the sick**, when that is not always what we are to do. We are told to **lay hands on the sick**.
- My granddaughter said---Jesus gives you what you wish for---a good positive---better than a lot of Christians---and exercise in childlike faith

More On Prayer---Another Look

Prayer---is for

- Fellowship
- Warfare
- Court—To Settle thing within—Jesus in Gethsemane
- To Exercise and Release faith

Prayer is not a show.
