Division III. Hobbyist Plant Designs (Classes D6 - D7)

Hobbyist Plant Design (Classes D6 - D7)

The exhibitor may use any aspect of the show theme "For the Love of Orchids" using any props of their choice to inspire their composition.

- D6. Hobbyist Designs – 1-3 plants

A tabletop design featuring 1 to 3 orchid plants. Staged on a table or other surface of the exhibitor's choice, contained within a space of less than 4 feet square in the center of the conservatory display area. The design may utilize props of the exhibitor's choice.

- D7. Hobbyist Designs – 4-10 plants

A tabletop design featuring 4 to 10 orchid plants. Staged on a provided 6-foot diameter round table, covered by a tablecloth provided by the exhibitor and placed in the center of the conservatory display area. May also be staged on a table or other surface provided by the exhibitor which is contained within a space of less than 6 feet square, in the center of the conservatory display area. This design may utilize props of the exhibitor's choice.
