

Unfrequented Paths 2024: Refuge

Sunday 30th June to Tuesday 30th July 2024

Call for Entries: Open Exhibition 2D/3D Artwork

In this, the second of our 'Unfrequented Paths' art exhibitions, the theme is 'Refuge', which we hope will nurture inspirational ideas relating to elements such as safety, structures, homes, relationships, and to wider issues such as stability and peace.

The exhibition will be in the Victorian farmhouse where Richard Jefferies grew up. It will feature up to thirty 2D pieces of work in the museum's gallery and ten 3D pieces of work inside or in the gardens. Work for the gardens will need to be mobile to enable it to be brought in during when the venue is closed.

N.B. Please pay via our website (discounts for multiple entries) and email us with a clear photo of your work, your name, an artist's statement of approximately 100 words, and dimensions of the artwork. The statement and picture will be used in the catalogue, if your work is selected.

Terms and Conditions of Entry:

- Open to artists of any media;
- Entries must show a connection to the theme, and be the artist's own, original artwork, produced within the last three years;
- Entry is £10 per work (there are discounts for multiple entries), with a maximum of 3 entries;
- All selected works will appear in a printed catalogue;
- All work will need to be insured by individual artists;
- 2D artwork must be easy to hang, with D-rings one third from the top of the frame. Maximum size 80cm x 65cm approx.. The walls of our gallery are fragile, so please consider weight;
- 3D artwork must be easy to move and will be selected on appropriateness for the gallery or garden. Bear in mind security/visitor safety etc.. Consideration of how work should be shown to be included within application, whether inside or outside;
- Deadline for submissions: Friday 14th June;
- If selected you will be notified by 19th June. Your work must then be delivered to the museum on either Thurs 20th, Sun 23rd, Mon 24th, Tues 25th June, or by arrangement;
- Exhibition will open with a preview event at 1pm on Saturday 29th June, and will run until 3pm on Tuesday 30th July;
- Exhibition will be open from 10am to 3pm every Sun, Mon, Tues, Wed and Thurs in July;
- Artists must arrange to have their work picked up between 10am and 4pm on Wed 31st July, Thurs 1st, Sun 4th, Mon 5th, Tues 6th, or Wed 7th August.

N.B. Submission of an entry constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
