The TCM curriculum courses includes comprehensive training in moxibustion, cupping, Guasha, and electrical stimulation. Clinical labs concentrate on accuracy needling methods, technique and precaution. The program is designed for students who want to know more about traditional Chinese medicine and how it helps our health. Students upon completion will be prepared to sit for the licensing exam administered by the California Board of Acupuncture.


