Directions:

From Interstate 40, Kingman Exit 51, Stockton Hill Rd:

- Drive south on Stockton Hill Road 1.6 miles to Route 66 (Stockton Hill Road becomes Hualapai Mountain Road at Route 66), continue on Hualapai Mountain Road for about 12 miles to the Hualapai Mountain Park entrance.
- Tell the Park Staff that you are with the Masons and there will be no entrance fee. Turn right immediately after the entrance gate and follow the signs to Recreational Area #3. The road is paved to the entrance of Recreational Area #3.
