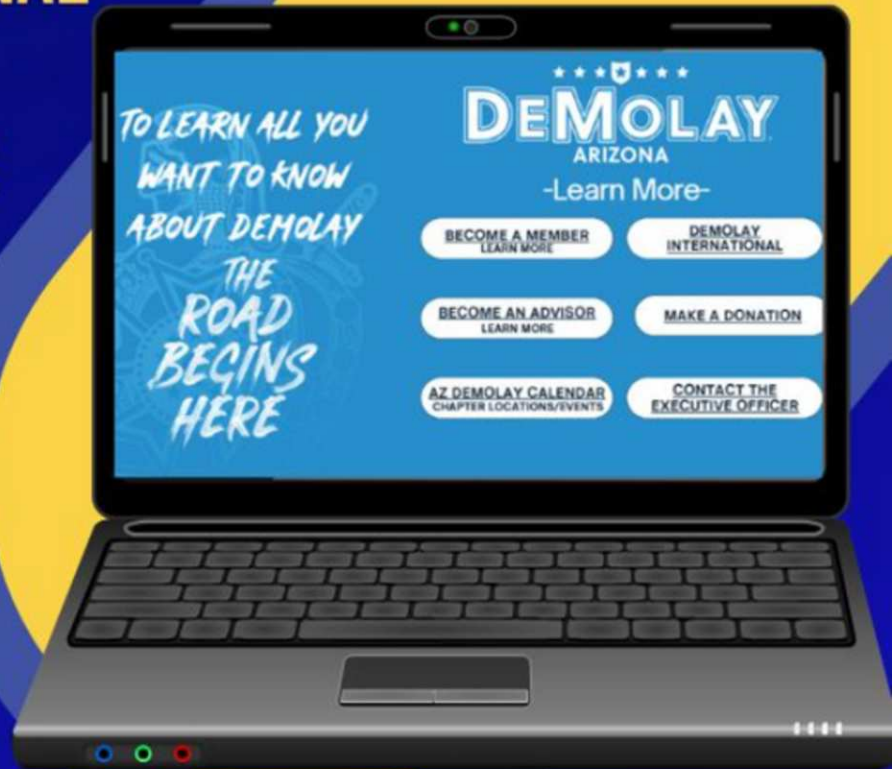
In 1916, the Prescott Square was bare -without a courthouse. Two previous courthouse buildings had existed in Prescott. The first, a 2 story loghouse, eventually burned down.

The second courthouse, built in 1878 on the Town Square, was a hodgepodge of additions and poor construction choices that became so unstable that one headline declared the "Building Trembles like Glass of Jelly". It was torn down to make way for the new building.

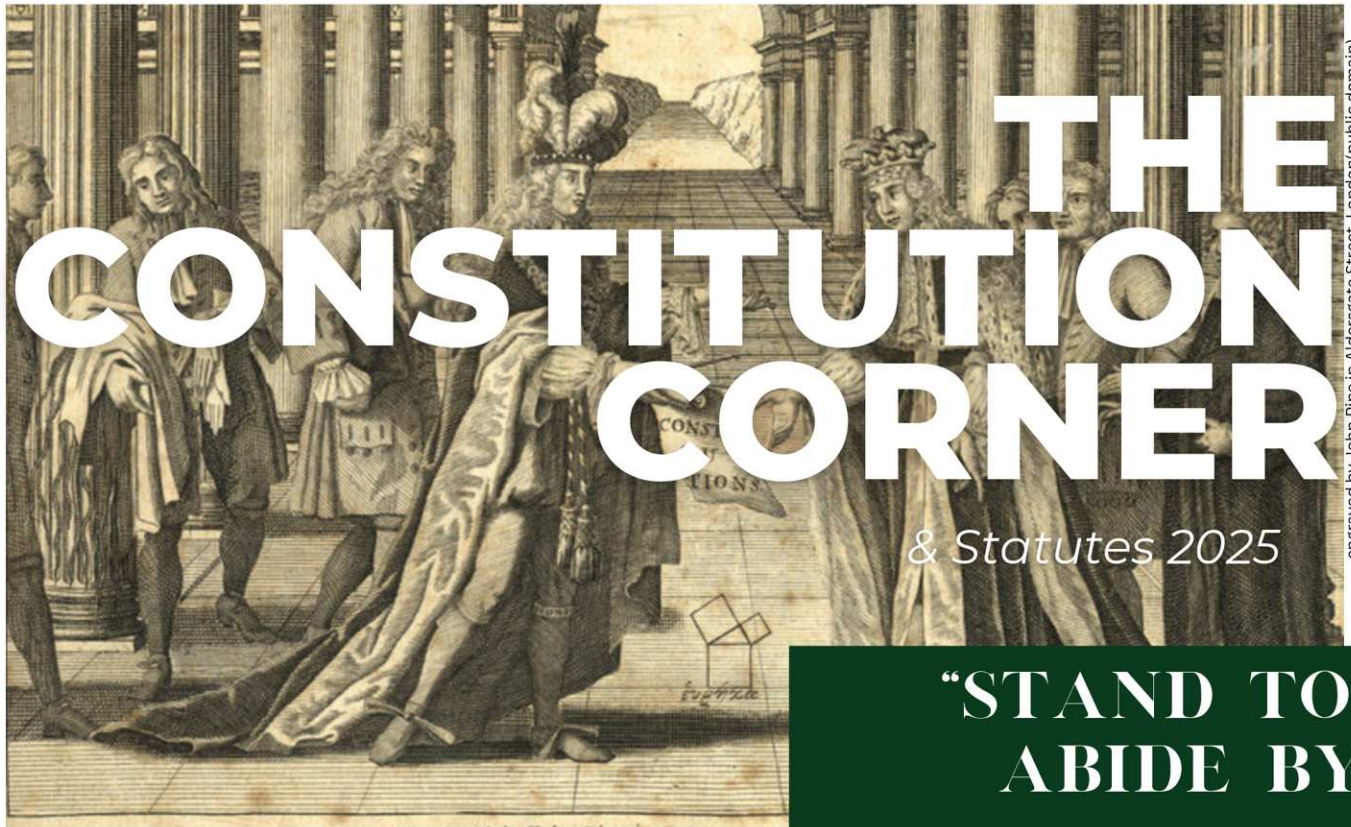

Section 5-203 – Privilege, Right and Duty to Ballot

The privilege, right and duty of a Mason to ballot as his conscience dictates is **inviolable**.

Any attempt to void an election or the rejection of a petitioner for the degrees or affiliation (except as set forth in Statute Section 5-201(b) for the possible correction of an error) by a second ballot on the same petition is a violation of a brother's rights and beyond the power of any Mason, Master and Grand Master inclusive.

Thoughts?

The right, privilege, and duty of a Mason to cast a ballot in accordance with his individual conscience shall be absolute and inviolable. Any action taken to nullify an election or to reverse the acceptance or rejection of a petitioner for the degrees or for affiliation—except as expressly permitted under Statute Section 5-201(b) for the correction of a verified error—through the use of a subsequent ballot on the same petition shall constitute a violation of the rights of a Brother and shall be deemed outside the lawful authority of any Mason, including the Master of the Lodge and the Grand Master.

What does this mean?

Every Mason has the protected right and responsibility to vote based on his own conscience, and that right cannot be taken away or overridden. Once a vote has been completed on a petition, no one can call for another vote to change the result, unless it is only to fix a proven mistake allowed under Statute Section 5-201(b). Trying to redo the vote would violate a Mason's rights, and no Mason — not even the Master or Grand Master — has the authority to allow it.

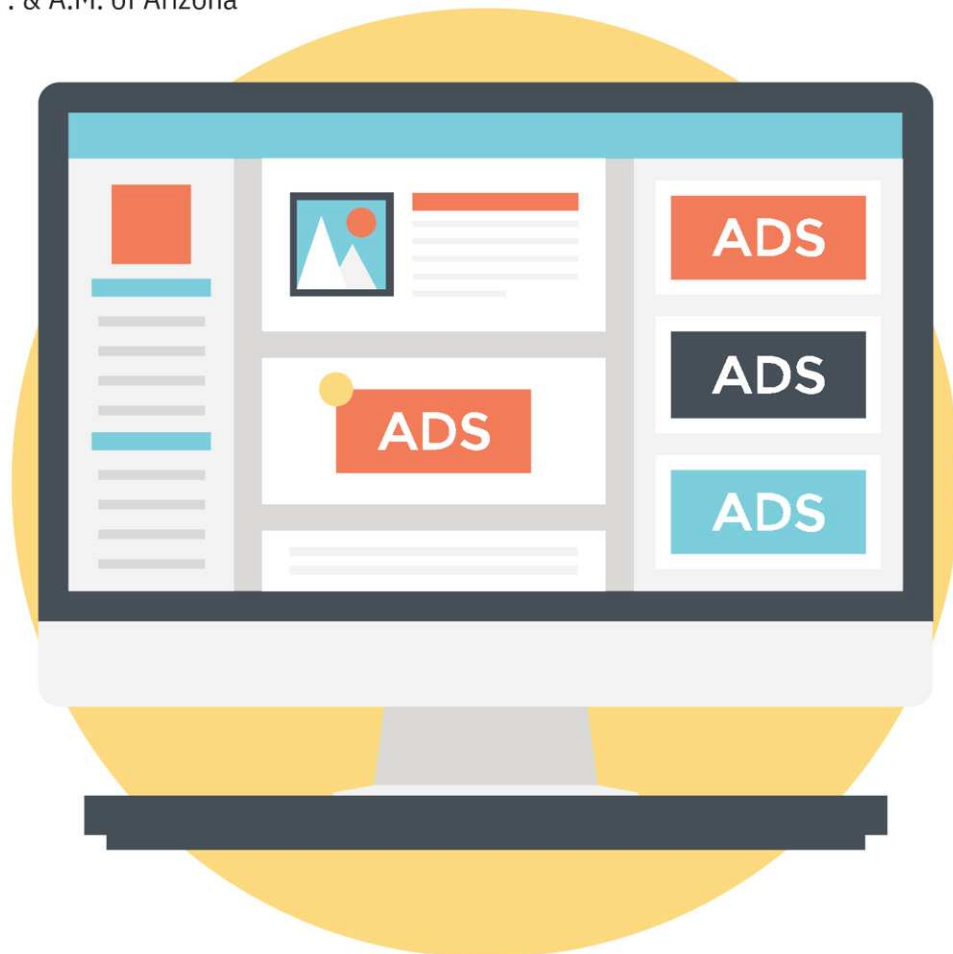

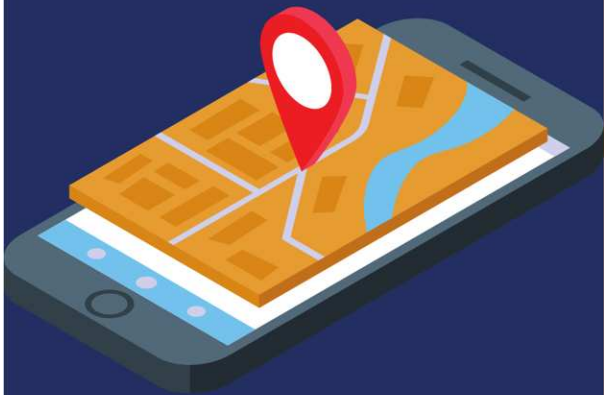
