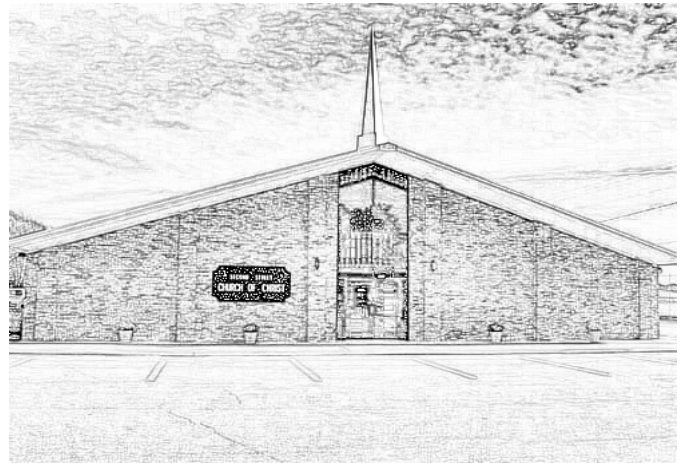

Ever had a tick on you? Ticks are small blood sucking mites. They spend a good bit of time just waiting in bushes, grass and woods for a victim—you! Once you happen by, they jump on and attempt to quickly crawl to a protected spot on your body. Then they sink their mouth parts into your flesh and begin to feed on life blood. If undetected, a tick will fill itself full and then drop off, often leaving its host inoculated with some debilitating disease such as spotted fever, relapsing fever, Lyme disease, tularemia, encephalitis or rickets. The tick is a lot like many kinds of sin:

- It may get on you when it is small and almost undetectable.
- It doesn't demand much sacrifice, but it may cause a little irritation.
- Once embedded, it's hard to get off.
- It gets bigger the longer it stays on you.
- It leaves you very seriously ill.

Some advice for dealing with ticks and sins:

**DON'T WALK IN PLACES THAT ARE INFESTED.** "See then that you walk circumspectly not as fools, but as wise (Ephesians 5:15).

**EXAMINE YOURSELF DAILY.** "Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith (2 Corinthians 13:5).

**HAVE OTHERS EXAMINE YOU, AND HELP EXAMINE THEM TOO.** "But exhort one another daily, while it is called 'Today', lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin" (Hebrews 3:13).

**IF ONE GETS ON YOU, GET IT OFF IMMEDIATELY.** "Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed" (James 5:16).

**IF YOU REALIZE YOU ARE GETTING SICK, SEE THE DOCTOR.** Jesus said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance" (Mark 2:17).

**Our Gospel Meeting** March 10 - 12. Chad Ramsey will be doing the speaking.

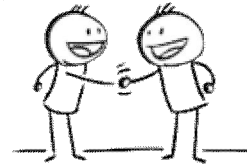

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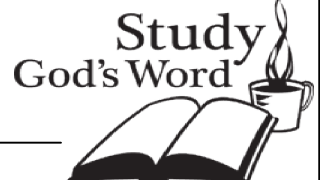
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# CHRIST AND THE DAY OF ATONEMENT

*Learning from Leviticus 16:1-24*

## INTRODUCTION

- ◆ There are many shadows in the Old Testament that are types of New Testament principles. (Hebrews 10:1; 8:5)
- ◆ These types foreshadowed what would come with Christ and the New Testament to help bring people to Christ. (Galatians 3:24)
- ◆ The Day of Atonement is one such type. (Leviticus 16)

## THE DAY OF ATONEMENT

- ◆ The priest was to make atonement for self and house first. (3-6)
- ◆ Two goats for the sacrifices for the people. (7)
- ◆ One goat sacrificed, the other a “scapegoat.” (8-10)
- ◆ Blood from the sacrifice to be sprinkled on the mercy seat. (14-15)
- ◆ Scapegoat sent outside the camp. (20-22)
- ◆ This was to be done every year. (29, 34)

## THE HIGH PRIEST

- ◆ DAY OF ATONEMENT
  - ◆ Aaron was the high priest for Israel.
  - ◆ He was not perfect, must offer sacrifices for himself. (Lev. 16:6; Heb. 9:7; 7:11)
- ◆ CHRIST
  - ◆ Jesus is our high priest today. (Heb. 8:1-5; 9:24)
  - ◆ He is ordained by God. (Psa. 110:4; Heb. 5:1-6)

## THE SACRIFICE

- ◆ DAY OF ATONEMENT
  - ◆ 2 goats brought before the people. (7-9)
  - ◆ 1 goat killed before the altar and sprinkled on mercy seat. (15-16)
- ◆ CHRIST
  - ◆ Jesus is our sacrifice today. (Heb. 9:12-14)
  - ◆ His sacrifice is perfect. (1 Pet. 2:21-24; Heb. 9:22-23; 10:9-10)

## THE SCAPEGOAT

- ◆ DAY OF ATONEMENT
  - ◆ The scapegoat took the sins of the people outside the camp. (21)
  - ◆ However, it still had to be done again the next year.
- ◆ CHRIST
  - ◆ Christ is our “scapegoat.” (Heb. 9:28; 2 Cor. 5:21)
  - ◆ His “propitiation” makes our sins remembered no more. (Heb. 8:12; 1 John 2:1-2)

## CONCLUSION

- ◆ The sacrifice of Jesus is like the sacrifices on the day of atonement, but with some marked differences.
- ◆ Jesus both offered the sacrifice as priest and was the sacrificial goat.
- ◆ His sacrifice only had to be made once.
- ◆ His propitiation for the sins of man is complete and everlasting.
