Ephesians 4:3*

Ephesians 4:6 tells us of “one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.” By right of creation all men stand under the Fatherhood of God (Acts 17:24-29); but by right of conversion, only those who are Christians can call God, “Our Father” (1 John 3:1). As our heavenly Father, God:

- 1. Provides for His children.** The blessings of providence are ever with us (Matthew 6:33; Romans 8:28). Spiritual provision (forgiveness of sins) has also been made (Ephesians 1:10).
- 2. Punishes or Disciplines His Household.** Earthly fathers have the right to administer discipline (Hebrews 12:2-12) and restrain children from wayward paths. The Heavenly Father does, too!
- 3. Hates sin.** Romans 1:18 says: “the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men...”
- 4. Loves Sinners.** Romans 5:8 teaches “But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”
- 5. Invites All to Come to Him.** Revelation 22:17 says, “And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.” Those who come to God through Christ by obeying the gospel are God’s family (Romans 5:1; 6:1-4, 16-18). Since the church is God’s family (1 Timothy 3:15), none of His children are outside the church. Is God your spiritual Father?

DWELLING WITH GOD

Examining Psalm 84:10-11

INTRODUCTION

SOMETIMES CHRISTIANS ARE ACCUSED OF BEING THOSE WHO DON'T BELIEVE IN EMOTION.

WHILE EMOTION SHOULD NOT BE THE SOLE REASON FOR ANYTHING WE DO, IT IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD.

JESUS WAS A MAN OF EMOTION, AND SO ARE WE. (JOHN 11:35; LUKE 22:44)

CONSIDER WHAT THE PSALMIST SAYS ABOUT THE EMOTION OF DWELLING WITH GOD.

TWO THOUGHTS

A DAY IN YOUR COURTS IS BETTER THAN A THOUSAND. (10)

A THOUSAND WHAT? DAYS ANYWHERE ELSE.

ONE DAY IN THE PRESENCE OF GOD IS MORE JOYFUL THAN BEING ANYWHERE ELSE. THIS IS THE THOUGHT OF THE CHILD OF GOD TOWARD WORSHIP.

I WOULD RATHER BE A DOORKEEPER... (10)

I WOULD RATHER HAVE THE LOWLIEST JOB THAN NOT BE THERE.

NOTHING WILL KEEP ME AWAY FROM GOD.

THE REASON WHY

GOD IS A SUN AND SHIELD. (11)

A SUN – THE LIGHT TO GUIDE US. (1 JOHN 1:7)

A SHIELD – TO PROTECT US. (PSALM 18:1-2; PROVERBS 30:5)

GOD WILL GIVE GRACE AND GLORY. (11)

GRACE – HE GIVES WHAT I DON'T DESERVE. (EPHESIANS 2:5; ROMANS 3:23-24)

GLORY – WE REFLECT THE GLORY OF GOD. (REVELATION 21:10-11)

HE WILL NOT WITHHOLD A GOOD THING. (11)

MATTHEW 7:9-11

EPHESIANS 3:17-20

FROM THOSE WHO WALK UPRIGHTLY. (11)

GOD SENDS RAIN ON THE JUST AND THE UNJUST. (MATTHEW 5:45)

BUT THE BLESSINGS OF GOD AND DELIVERANCE OF HIS GRACE IS ONLY FOR THOSE THAT FOLLOW HIM. (2 THESSALONIANS 1:10; EPHESIANS 1:3-7)

CONCLUSION

THE CHRISTIAN SHOULD BE FAR FROM AN EMOTIONLESS INDIVIDUAL.

INSTEAD, WE SHOULD BE A PEOPLE FILLED WITH JOY AND COMFORT.
