A Message to the Circuit from Burton Hospital Chaplains

Dear Friends & Colleagues,

We are currently looking to recruit 10 - 12 new chaplaincy volunteers from members of local faith communities or accredited humanist pastoral care networks, whom you feel can be recommended to join our team of chaplains and volunteers. There are opportunities to volunteer at the Queen's Hospital, Burton, the Samuel Johnson Community Hospital in Lichfield or the Sir Robert Peel in Tamworth.

Chaplaincy volunteers must be able to work as part of the inter-faith team, working with people of all faiths and none, respecting a diversity of beliefs, and must be willing to offer one morning or afternoon on a weekly basis.

Anyone who is interested will be asked to complete a registration form and on receipt of this will be invited to attend a Volunteers Open Session run by the hospital's Volunteer Coordinator where they will be introduced to various different volunteering opportunities within the Trust, including Chaplaincy Visiting. **The next Open Session is on Friday 7th September**. After discussion with the Head of Spiritual Care Services, prospective chaplaincy volunteers will be given training and support. The next training program is scheduled to start on **Tuesday 25th September with 5 weekly sessions**, each lasting for 1.5-2 hours on a Tuesday afternoon.
