

Quick Chick Pattern

Materials:

Two colors of super wash wool (yellow and orange are the traditional choice)

size 10 crochet hook

two 6mm plastic eyes

Rd1: Magic loop with 6 stitches (6 st)

Rd2: Increase in each stitch (12 st)

Rd3: Stitch 1, increase 1 repeat three times (18 st)

Rd4: Stitch 2, increase 1 repeat three times (24 st)

Rd5-10: Stitch in each stitch (24 st)

Rd11: Stitch 2, decrease 1 repeat three times (18 st)

Rd12: Stitch 1, decrease 1 repeat 3 times (12 st)

Rd13: Decrease each stitch (6 st)

Fasten off and leave a tail

Stuff through the hole

Synch up the hole using the tail

Add eyes between rounds 7-8

Embroider a beak between the eyes

Stitch on a Cancer Kickin' Critter tag or drop it in the box at Nature's Yarn in Fairfax, VA

Send with love to a child fighting cancer
