

Rybicki Trucking Co., Inc.

Estimate Terms and Conditions

This estimate is valid for thirty (30) days from date of issuance.

Unless arrangements are made prior to loading, all transportation charges are to be paid via wire transfer before delivery. If credit is awarded, payment is due within 14 days of the date of the invoice and all charges are subject to a 1.5% per day late fee.

The estimate is base on weights and dimensions provided by the customer.

The shipper and the consignee are responsible for providing clear and direct access to and from the job site.

The shipper and the consignee are to assist in the assembly and disassembly of all Rybicki Trucking Co., Inc. equipment when needed.

This estimate may not include charges for city and county permits or costs associated with the requirements imposed by local officials.

This estimate is contingent upon securing any needed permits from all proper governing agencies.

It is the responsibility of the shipper, contractor or consignee to post any bond required for this move on city, county or state highway. This cost is not included in this estimate.

On new commodities cargo liability is limited to \$2.50 a pound or a maximum of \$250,000 per shipment. On used or reconditioned commodities cargo liability is limited to upset damage only in the total amount of \$5,000.00. If excess is required, Rybicki Trucking Co., Inc. must be notified in writing prior to loading and the excess amount charges must be agreed upon in writing. The declared amount must be stated upon the bill of lading to assure full cargo protection.

The shipper is required to supply blocking and bracing for each shipment.

This quote reflects an estimate base on the center of gravity of the piece being evenly distributed, if the not the customer must provide a drawing to reflect the actual center of gravity for trailer and deck adjustments.

This estimate does not include engineering or bridge study fees. If required, will be cost plus 15%.

Depending on the size and weight of the shipment, please allow a minimum of 30 days advance notice to organize equipment and secure the necessary permits. Some states require a minimum of 6 to 8 weeks to issue a permit.

The shipper will be required to provide documentation for support letters when needed.

This estimate does not include utilities, bucket trucks or movement of obstructions. If required, these fees will be billed at cost plus 15%.

This quote is base on loading and unloading during normal business hours. In order to accommodate loading or unloading that requires weekend, holiday, layover or circumstantial hours of operation, additional charges will need to be assessed.

Rybicki Trucking Co., Inc. allows 3 hours of free time for loading and unloading of our equipment. Once free time has elapsed, detention will be assessed on an hourly basis and is tiered based on the type of equipment used to transport the commodity.

Any additional charges or delays due to inclement weather conditions are not the responsibility of Rybicki Trucking Co., Inc.
