A longtime pastor, speaker and teacher, mentor and coach, Dale has been a community leader for over 30 years. After officiating at hundreds of weddings and counseling countless couples through marriage difficulties, Dale found himself divorced.

Determined to continue serving hurting and wounded people, he started *Men's Divorce Recovery*.

Knowing the stakes are high, Dale is determined to make a difference in men's lives as they face recovery and rebuilding from the trauma and losses of divorce.

Dale has pastored six churches in Texas and New England, traveled and taught overseas and led Men's Retreats and Conferences. He has taught in numerous prisons and been a chaplain in the hospice, hospital and first responder settings.

## THE WHOLE STORY

When a freshman at the University of Texas, Dale was called to pastor a small church West of Austin, Texas. So began a lifetime of commitment to helping others touching hundreds of people spanning three continents.

After UT, Dale enrolled in South-western Baptist Theological Seminary, pastoring two small country churches while earning his M.Div. and Ph.D. degrees.

Dale and his family then traveled to Tanzania, East Africa, to teach seminary-level classes to students from seven countries. An unknown illness struck his 7-year-old daughter, forcing a medical evacuation from Nairobi to Johannesburg, South Africa, where a team of doctors saved his daughter's life.

Returning to Austin to pastor Crestview Baptist Church, Dale and his staff employed Saddleback Church's The Purpose Driven Church in an attempt to revitalize a dying church.

Next came 13 years in New England where Dale pastored a vibrant church of 500.

In his 13 years as Lead Pastor at West Church, Dale:

Led in Men's Ministry by serving on the Men's Ministry
 Leadership Team, leading several ongoing Bible studies for men and speaking at several
 Men's Retreats and local men's events.

- Established life groups ministering through triads, quads, and groups of 8 to 12.
- Established and sustained an active Stephen Ministry, along with ongoing groups for Divorce Recovery, GriefShare and Celebrate Recovery.
- Helped veterans in the church form a Ministry Team to reach combat veterans in the community.
- Led in the successful implementation of a capital fundraising campaign, raising over \$750,000.
- Expanded the mission education, giving and involvement of the church, particularly overseas in Central America and East Africa.
- Led in three special emphases:
   "Faith & Politics," "Faith & Science," and "Faith & Art."

Every week more than 15,000 divorces take place plunging more than 30,000 people into a black hole of pain, confusion and hurt. Though never expecting himself to be one of these men, Dale experienced divorce after 32 years of marriage.

Determined to GET UP rather to give up, Dale started *Men's Divorce Recovery* to rescue men devastated by divorce.




