

Dr. Ofotokun M.D. M.Sc. is a Professor of Medicine (Division of Infectious Diseases) at the Emory University SOM, and a Professor of Behavioral Science and Health Education, at the Emory RSPH. His career is centered on providing care for women living with HIV, clinical/translational research in women's health and HIV, research education, and mentoring trainees interested in HIV and women's health research. Within this context, he has focused his attention on antiretroviral clinical pharmacology and long-term complications of HIV infection. His credentials in this regard have been enhanced by a master of science in clinical research (MSc) degree, and recipient of patient-oriented mentored awards earlier in his career including the Building Interdisciplinary Research Careers in Women's Health (BIRCWH) Award and the NIH-K-23 Award.
