Monday:

8 Times Each With Parts of Speech

•This means you write the words 8 times each in your best writing and study their spellings. You also need to see how the word is being used or the ways in which they can be used. This is the part of speech.

Tuesday:

Sentences & Assigned Pages

Write a sentence using each of the 12 words. Sentences must be complete and contain at least 8 other words. Do this in your Word Work notebook.

You are to complete pages 8 & 9. Read very carefully and study EVERYTHING on the page. This is how you will understand and build your vocabulary.

Wednesday:

Synonyms/Antonyms & Assigned Text Pages

Write a synonym and antonym for each word in your Word Work notebook.

Do pages 10-12. Really focus on what you are doing.

Thursday:

Complete Assigned Text Pages & Homework

Do pages 13 - 15. Really focus on what you are doing.

HOMEWORK: Study for test. Be sure you know definitions, synonyms & antonyms (even if they are not in the book), part of speech, and how words can be used in sentences.
