8/1/1779—1/11/1843 **Francis Scott Key** (Lawyer, author, & poet, who wrote the words to "The Star-Spangled Banner".)

8/3/1941 **Martha Steward** (76) Television host, author, and magazine publisher.

8/3/1926 **Tony Bennett** (91) Singer of popular music, standards, show tunes, and jazz.

8/4/1901--7/6/1971 **Louis Armstrong** (Jazz trumpeter and singer. Nick-named Satchmo.)

8/5/1930 – 8/25/12 **Neil Armstrong** (Aviator, astronaut, test pilot, aerospace engineer, and university professor. He was the first person to set foot on the Moon.)

8/6/1911--4/26/1989 **Lucille Ball** (A comedienne, film, television, stage and radio actress, model, film and television executive, and star of the sitcom I Love Lucy.)

8/8/1921—06/2013 **Esther Williams** (Competitive swimmer and movie star.)

8/10/1928--6/13/2010 **Jimmy Dean** (Country music singer, television host, actor & businessman.)

8/12/1881--1/22/1959 **Cecil B. DeMille** (A film director & Academy Award-winning film producer.)

8/13/1899--4/29/1980 **Sir Alfred Hitchcock** (English filmmaker and producer who pioneered many techniques in the suspense and psychological thriller genres.)

8/15/1912--8/13/2004 **Julia Child** (A chef, author, and television personality.)

8/17/1893--11/22/1980 **Mae West** (An actress, playwright, screenwriter, and sex symbol.)

8/17/1786--3/6/1836 **Davy Crockett** (An American folk hero, frontiersman, soldier & politician.)

8/18 Kristie Ashby

8/18/1928 **Rosalynn Carter** (89) Wife of the former President Jimmy Carter.

8/19/1946 **Bill Clinton** (71) Former President of the United States.

8/19/1871--1/30/1948 **Orville Wright** (One of the two brothers who are generally credited with inventing and building the world's first successful airplane.)

8/22 Jim Furry

8/23/1912--2/2/1996 **Gene Kelly** (An actor, dancer, singer, director, producer & choreographer.)

8/25/1931 **Regis Philbin** (86) Media personality. Best known for hosting talk and game shows.

8/25/1930 **Sean Connery** (87) Scottish actor and producer. Best known for starring as James Bond in seven films.

8/26/1910--9/5/1997 **Mother Teresa** (The Nun who founded the Missionaries of Charity in Kolkata.)

8/29/1915--8/29/1982 **Ingrid Bergman** (A Swedish actress noted for her roles in American films.)

8/30/1908--11/5/1991 **Fred MacMurray** (An actor who appeared in more than 100 movies and a successful television series.)

8/31/1924--6/30/2003 **Buddy Hackett** (A comedian and actor.)

8/31/1903--3/16/1983 **Arthur Godfrey** (A radio and television broadcaster and entertainer.)

8/31/1870--5/6/1952 **Maria Montessori** (Best known for her philosophy, and the Montessori method of education of children from birth to adolescence.)
