

CLASS 1A. SCISSOR FOB AND CORDING CLASS

Instructor: Vonna Pfeiffer

Cost:

\$50.00 Cost includes chart, fabric, cording drill, finishing material, and instructor fee. DMC floss packs used in the model are available for an additional charge.

Skills Needed/Level:

Basic: must be able to cross stitch, backstitch and understand simple hand-sewing techniques

What:

We will be learning how to put a fob together using complete hand sewing for construction. This simple technique learned in this class may be used to make pillow ornaments and/or small tuck pillows – for those of you who may be hesitant to use a sewing machine. We also will be learning how to make: single, bi-color and triple color cording with demonstrations by Vonna in class and the opportunity to make your own single color cording to finish your fob during class.

Stitch

The exclusive design by Vonna Pfeiffer, The Twisted Stitcher entitled: Bee Kind, which will be constructed into a fob during class.

Time

Class will last approximately 2 hours

Pre-Work Required

The design “Bee Kind” must be fully stitched, front and back, with back-stitched frame as directed on pattern. Kits will be mailed mid-January for you to have time to complete all pre-work.

What To Bring To Class

The fully Stitched Piece, Sewing Scissors, Tapestry Needle, 6 skeins of DMC that you wish to make into cording for your fob, and extra lighting/magnification as needed.

Class Size

Class is limited to 30 attendees. We will NOT accept registrations after the limit is hit, get your registration in quickly

Items available, for an additional fee

\$7.80 DMC floss packs. This pack will include enough floss to stitch the design and make the cording, in the colors shown.



CLASS 1B. INTERMEDIATE FINISHING PLUM STREET TARTS

Cost

\$75.00 Cost includes choice of Linen or Aida fabric, chart, finishing material, and instructor fee.

Skills Needed/Level

Intermediate. Must have basic finishing knowledge and confidence; basic sewing skills a plus.

Time

Class will last approximately 2 hours

Pre-Work Required

Chart must be fully stitched using fabric that is included. Kits will be mailed mid-January for you to have time to complete all pre-work.

What To Bring To Class

Your fully stitched pieces, extra lighting/magnification as needed, large pair of scissors to cut mat board, needlework scissors, and tapestry needle.

Class Description

In this class your class pack will contain everything to finish one of Plum Street Sampler's mini tarts. These cute designs are not only popular - but the skills gained in this class can be used to create box toppers, round pin cushions, round ornaments and the like. Vonna will give you her "insider" tips and tricks on how to create plump tarts that stand above the rim so that your finish may stand above the crowd.

CLASS 2A. BASIC HARDANGER

\$40.00 Cost includes fabric, chart, and instructor fee.

Skills Needed/Level:

Basic

Time:

Class will last approximately 2 hours. The instructor will be available after the class and during the weekend for questions.

Pre-Work Required.

None required.

What To Bring To Class:

Student to bring 2 skeins #3 Pearl Cotton, 1ea white and 1ea color for star, 1ball #8 Pearl Cotton in accent color for eyelets, #22 needle, 8" hoop or Q-Snap, and light/magnification, if needed.

Class Description:

Learn the basics of Hardanger embroidery while you create this lovely piece. Emphasis will be on good technique including stitch direction and traveling techniques, choosing fabrics and threads, and adding embellishments. Stitches include Klosters, Eyelet, and Satin Stitch. Finish as you choose.

Items available, for an additional fee

DMC Pearl Cotton floss packs will be available and will include the floss colors shown in the design. Hoops and 8" Q-Snaps are also available for purchase. These items will be provided at the retreat (not mailed separately).



CLASS 2B. INTERMEDIATE HARDANGER

\$75.00 Cost includes fabric, Caron Collection fiber pack, chart, and instructor fee. (Hardanger scissors available for additional cost)

Skills Needed/Level:

Intermediate

Time:

Class Schedule. Thursday 4:00–6:00pm and 7:00–8:00pm AND Friday 1:30-5:00pm. Instructor will be available throughout the weekend for questions and finishing instructions.

Pre-Work Required.

Yes. Kits will be mailed mid-January for you to have time to complete all pre-work.

What To Bring To Class:

Student to bring 8" hoop or Q-Snap, sharp scissors, and light/magnification if needed. Don't forget to bring your piece with pre-work completed!

Class Description:

Take your Hardanger to the next level with this interesting project. Emphasis will be on the Surface Embroidery and Needle weaving. Stitches include Klosters, Wrapped Bars, Needle weaving, Eyelets, Smyrna, Fly Stitch, French Knot, Lazy Daisy, and Cross Stitch.

Items available, for an additional fee

Handmade box for finishing and hardanger scissors available for purchase. In order to receive a \$20 discount and the box at the retreat, boxes must be paid ordered by November 1,2017.
