

## **GiftAid Questions**

- GiftAid What is it? ~ GiftAid allows charities like OXSRAD to reclaim the tax paid on subscriptions or freely given donations at NO COST to the donor. The scheme was introduced in the UK in April 2000 and we are able to reclaim tax on all contributions going back to that date.
- Is it just my membership fee that qualifies? ~ We are able to reclaim tax on any contribution that is made without a specific service or benefit being provided. So if you would like at any stage to make a further donation to OXSRAD, we can also reclaim tax on that. We are not able to reclaim tax back on payments you make for a specific benefit such as participation in our 200 Club, fees for use of the gym or money paid at the café/bar. But obviously we want you to keep using these opportunities.
- What if I'm not a Taxpayer? ~ No problem. Just tick the box above and return the form to us. That way we won't trouble you with further GiftAid material. Your fees are still very valuable to us.
- You reclaim tax at 28% yet the basic rate of tax is 22%. How come? ~ This is because the basic rate of tax is calculated on the gross amount of the donation. A net fee of £100, when grossed up at 22% gives the sum of £128.21. The tax repayment is therefore £128.21 less £100 – i.e £28.21. Don't worry too much about the maths!
- You reclaim tax at 28% (or 22% see above), yet I pay the full rate of 40% tax. Can OXSRAD reclaim more? ~ No. Our limit is set at the lower rate. However if you pay tax at the full rate, you can reclaim for yourself the difference between the 22% explained above and the 40% rate - i.e 18%.
- If I sign the form will OXSRAD be able to see details of my income? ~ Absolutely not. We receive no information from the Inland Revenue—just the money! All you need to do is say whether the total tax you pay in a year will exceed the money we will reclaim. For example, for a family membership of £85.00, we can reclaim the tax if you pay more than £23.80 in Income or Capital Gains Tax. (To work it out multiply the fee by 22% or 28%)
- Will I need to fill out a declaration every year? ~ No. Just the once will do. Let us know if your tax paying status changes at any stage.
