

WE CARE

My name is Michelle L. and I was in need of rental assistance for one month. I was in a dire situation and unable to pay all my rent for the month of April 2016. I lost my job in February of 2016 and was unable to obtain work until March 25, 2016. My husband is disabled and does receive \$1,146 a month for social security and I was paying the balance of the rent out of my pay. Since I was not working I was unable to save all my rent due in April. I recently obtained my two grandchildren ages 9 and 12 and have

really been struggling with making ends meet. I am employed now for the last two days and will be working minimal hours such as 2 to 4 hours per day, however that will make up the difference needed for the rent starting in May.

Thank you for helping me and my family in this current situation, we really appreciate it.
