We are delighted to have Maureen London join our club this month and two more members to be voted in at our December board meeting. Welcome!

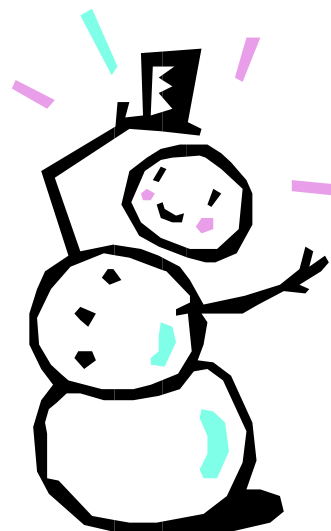
I hope you and all our members can join us in the parade next month – or at least watch. We're certainly going to be something special in our old fashion bathing suits or our red and

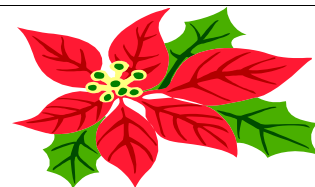
