Updates on Potable Water Stations and Shower Facilities for At Risk Well Users

Aztec, NM – Residents with at risk wells that need assistance with showers will be able to access the McGee Park Showers from 9am to 5pm, Monday 8/10/15 – Saturday 8/15/15, by picking up a special pass at the Lee Acres Sheriff's Sub Station – 21 RD 5500.

Showers and a drinking water fill station have also been made available from 9am – 3pm, Monday 8/10/15 – Friday 8/14/15, at the National Guard Station – 1101 W. Navajo St. – Farmington. Contact Major Peete. For both shower stations, you must bring your own towel and supplies.
