**NOTICE OF WATER OUTAGE
HARVEST GOLD SUBDIVISION
TUESDAY - JULY 25, 2017
STARTING AT 9AM – LASTING 2 – 4 HOURS**

Bloomfield - Bloomfield Public Works Department will be installing a “T-in” line as part of the construction associated with connection of the Apple Orchard Mutual Domestic Water Consumers Association that serves the Harvest Gold Subdivision east of Bloomfield, to the City of Bloomfield Water line.

To complete this portion of construction, Apple Orchard MDWCA lines must be shut down. Residents are being asked to fill bathtubs with water to be used for flushing toilets and to turn off swamp coolers.

Water will be shut off at 9am on Tuesday, July 25th for at least 2 hours but possibly up to 4 hours, depending on construction progress.

Bloomfield Public Works and the Apple Orchard MDWCA would like to thank residents in advance for their patience with the construction that will ultimately ensure clean drinking water to the community.

San Juan County continues to offer affected residents of Harvest Gold Subdivision access to showers and a drinking water fill station at McGee Park from 6am to 8pm daily.

Bloomfield Fire has made available a drinking water fill station at the main Fire Station next to City Hall, from 8am to 5pm, Monday thru Thursday.
