Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are planning Vacation Bible School for <u>Monday</u>, <u>July 11th</u> <u>through Thursday</u>, <u>July 14th</u> in the afternoons from <u>8am to 11am</u>. Our theme will be *An Adventure Through God's Great*, *Big*, *Beautiful World*. A registration form is included in this packet and postcard reminders will be sent in early June. Students in pre-K through 6th grade are welcome to come to VBS. Junior high and high school students are invited to come as helpers.



Our first day of religious education and youth groups for the 2022-2023 school year will be **September 14th** and the last day will be April 19th.

As always, we are looking for volunteers to help make our program great. Our volunteers work in teams of two with one person as the leader and the other as an aide.

We are using the same Gospel Weeklies program for religious education that we have used in the past. Each week the children hear and learn about the upcoming Sunday's Gospel and how it incorporates into their lives.

In order to help fund our religious education program, we have a \$20 per child fee to help cover the program and snack costs. This fee is waived for volunteers with children in the program and there are scholarships available for those families that need it.

All children are welcome to come to the Parish Center after school beginning at 3:15pm where they can play in the gym and have a snack before class time begins at 4pm. Church Time ends our religious education program from 5:05-5:20pm. All parishioners and parents are welcome to join us for this Church Time where children can be picked up. We encourage you to come to daily Mass on Wednesdays is at 5:30pm after religious education.

Junior High youth group will meet from 4:00-5:20pm in the Parish Center and High School youth group will meet from 6:00-7:30pm. We will work with parents to provide a meal for students staying for high school youth group from 5:30-6:00pm.

We will continue to have the Scripture Challenge this year since our students loved it these last few years. For the first fifteen verses memorized there will be a prize and a second prize for memorizing all twenty seven. This list will be given to students on the first day of class, September 14th.
