Christmas Cantata

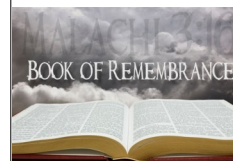

Liturgical notes



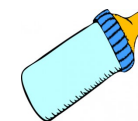

Book of Remembrance

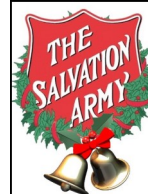


The Book of Remembrance is located by the baptismal font. Please take a page to decorate as your family remembrance page.

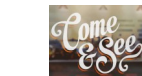
