WASHING LINENS 2018

(Many have discovered diff. ways to remove stains— here are a few suggestions)

Take Shout (stick works best) and apply to lipstick areas, grease spots, etc.
or pre-soak with Oxiclean.

Presoak in warm/cold water overnight.

Wring the cloths out by hand - and dispose of the water so no one will walk on it. (Ex. In flower bed or against a wall)

In the washer wash linens with a small amount of Clorox or Purex (amount depends on size of load) and hot water.

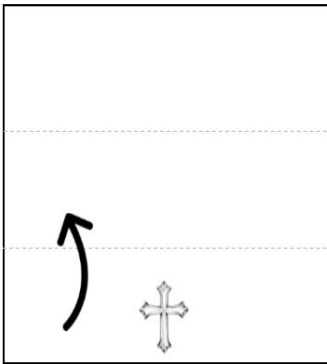
Linens are pressed and folded in three sections vertically with each side overlapping the other (Left over Right). Press.
Then fold in half and pressed - fold so purificators are approximately 3 x 8 (Top to bottom).

The Corporal is pressed and folded the same and then folded in thirds and pressed. (Top folded 2/3 way down from top, then bottom folded up 1/3. Press.)

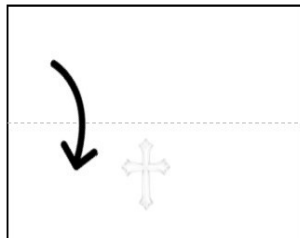
The Corporal:

Start with Good side up

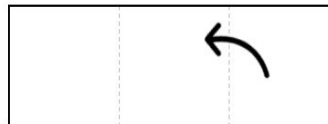
Step 1: fold bottom third up



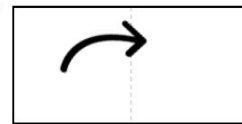
Step 2: fold top half down

Step 4: fold left side over



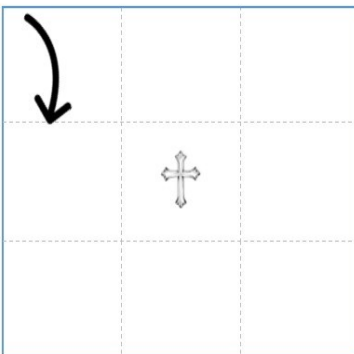
Result,

inside



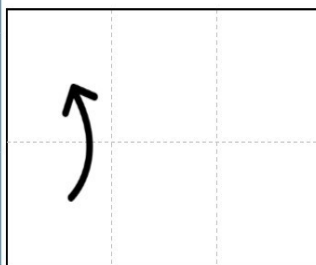
The Purificator:

Start with Good side down

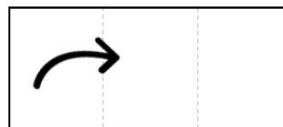
Step 1: fold top third down



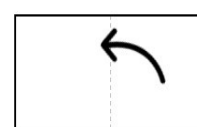
Step 2: fold Bottom third up
